Since mid-April 2023, following the violent crisis that erupted in Sudan between the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF), and the Rapid Support Forces (RSF), the Central African Republic (CAR) is receiving thousands of Sudanese refugees through several **À**⇒ 30,108 9,138 border crossings, majority coming through Am-dafock, in the Vakaga region of CAR. UNHCR and the National Commission for Refugees (CNR) are coordinating border Households People arriving from monitoring, reception, screening, and registration of new arrivals. Along with the CNR Sudan and the humanitarian community (including UN Agencies, International and Local NGO's) UNHCR has been providing lifesaving assistance including protection services, food, CRIs, emergency shelter, health care and education in Korsi, a settlement identified by the government in Birao town, Vakaga 6,158 ⊊ \$ 23,950 Prefecture, 65 km from Am-dafock border. Some 10,000 Sudanese refugees are also scattered in hard-to reach locations outside of Vakaga prefecture and in need of assistance and protection.
