WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased from 932,800 last week to 934,000 this week.

In Kayah State, 5,022 people from Hsihseng Township were displaced to Loikaw Township, while destination of some of them was to the rural area of Hsihseng itself due to clashes and shelling. Within this number, 3,952 of those heading to Loikaw Township went as a secondary displacement. On the other hand, 167 IDPs returned to their places of origin in Demoso Township.

In Shan State (South), 230 IDPs from Hsihseng were displaced within the same township due to the fighting. In contrast, 965 IDPs returned to their places of origin in Loikaw Township and Demoso Township.

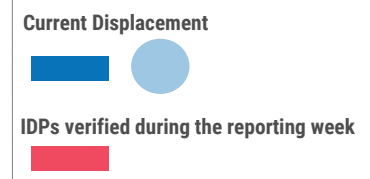
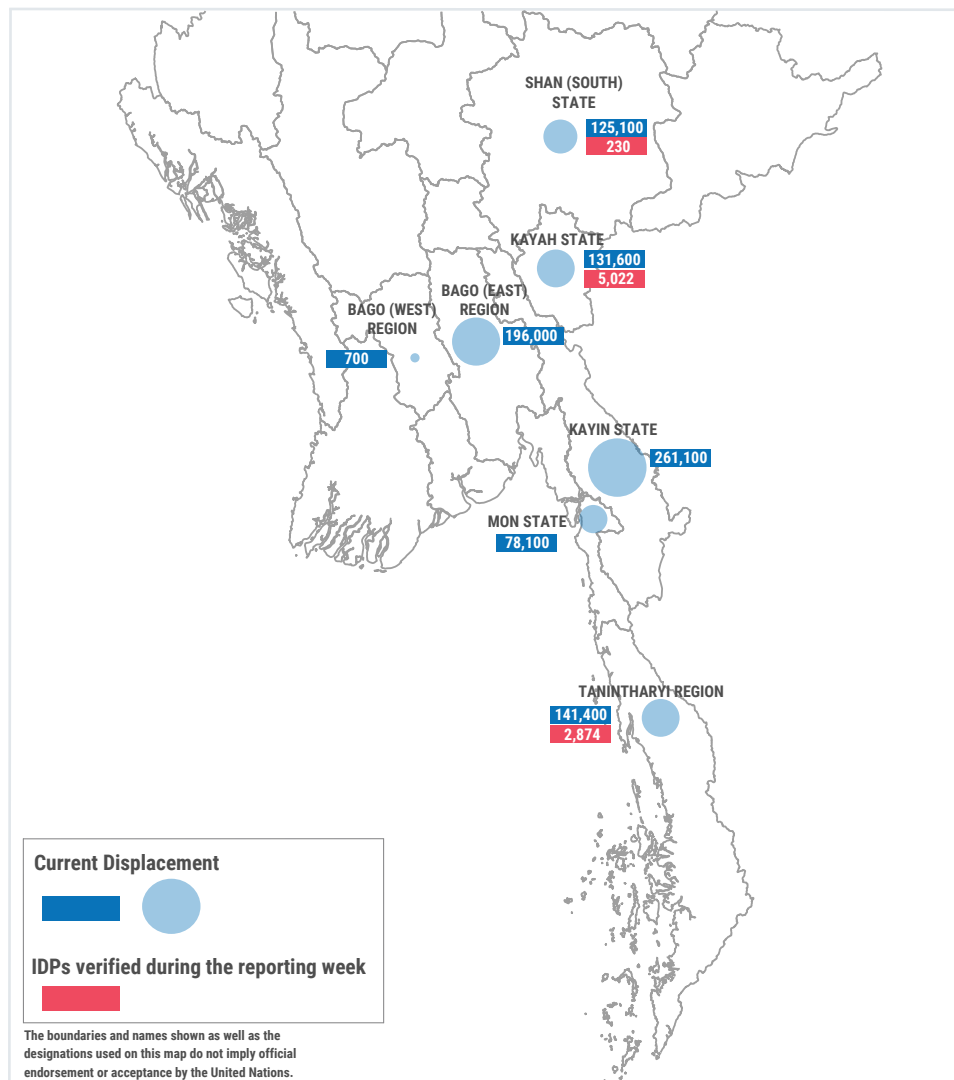
In Tanintharyi Region, 2,874 people from Tanintharyi Township were displaced within the same township due to the intensified fighting in the area. Out of them, 1,845 IDPs were displaced for a second time.

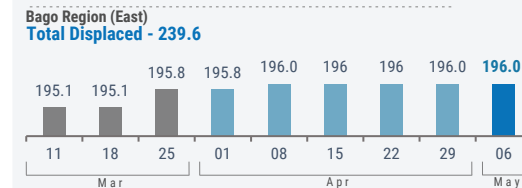
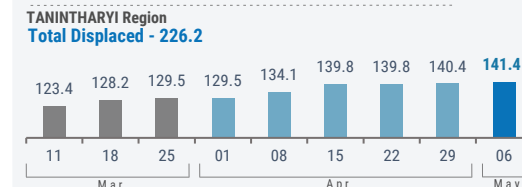
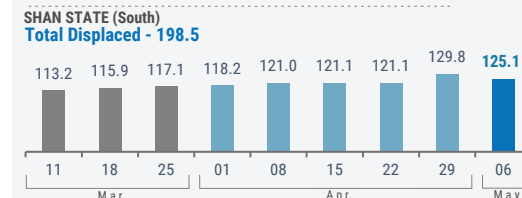
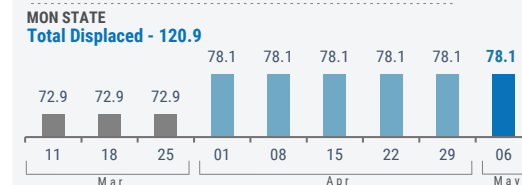
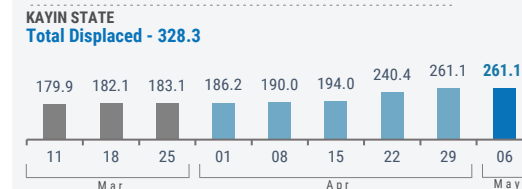
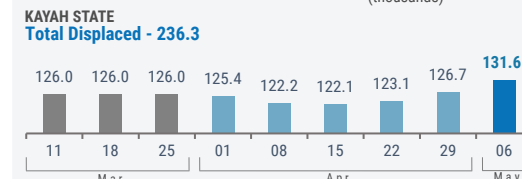
