


MYANMAR SOUTH EAST - EMERGENCY OVERVIEW MAP

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) decreased from 915,800 last week to 913,300 this week.


In Kayah State, due to increased fighting, over 400 IDPs from Hsihseng Township were displaced to Loikaw Township. However, 105 IDPs from Loikaw Township were able to return to Loikaw Town.

In Kayin State, some 130 IDPs from Hpapun Township were displaced within the same township due to the conflict situation. Meanwhile, over 1,700 IDPs returned to their place of origin in Kawkareik Township.

In Shan State (South), over 800 IDPs from Hsihseng and Demoso Townships returned to their place of origin; 600 IDPs returned to Hsihseng Town; and 210 IDPs returned to Demoso Township.
