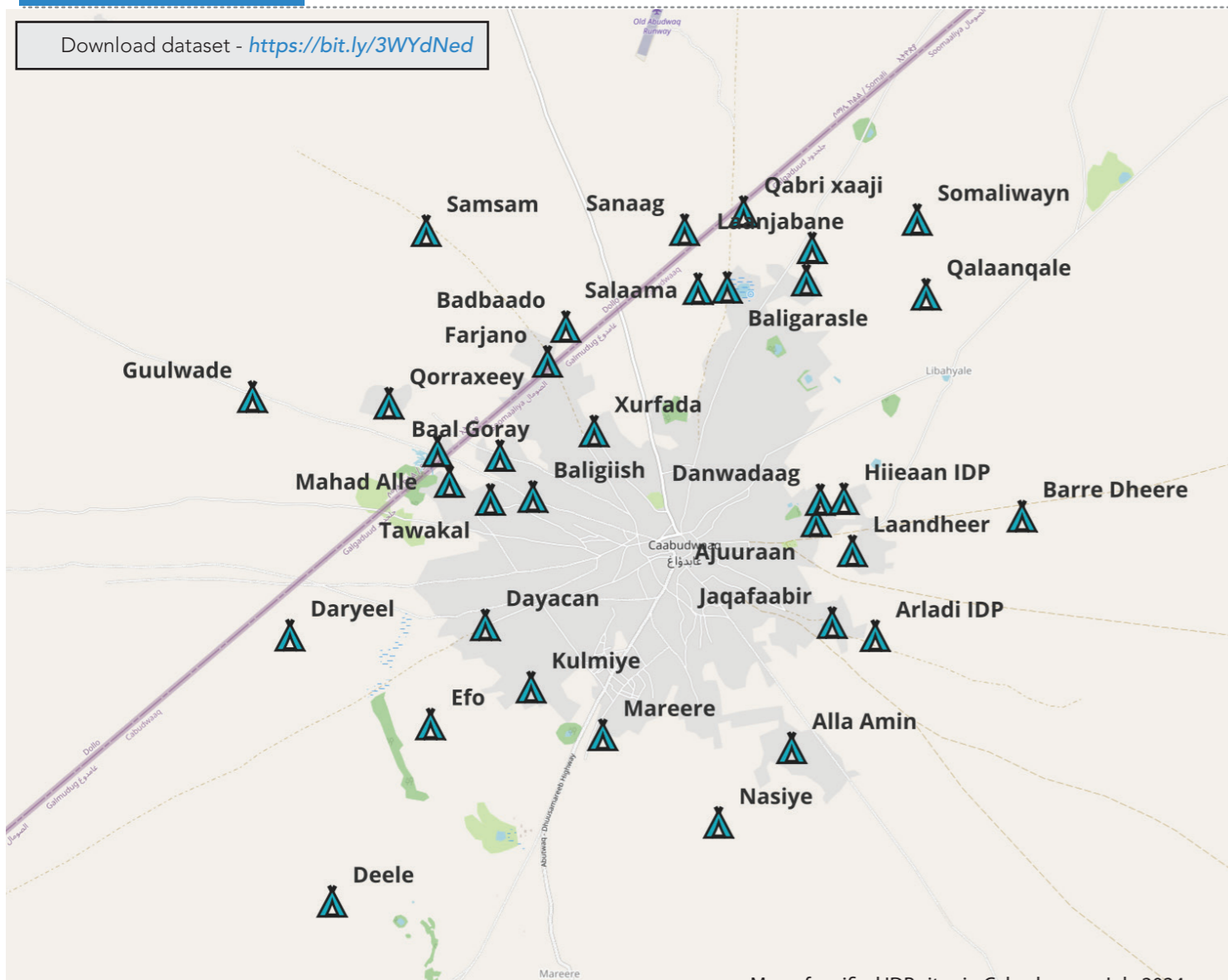

Assessment overview

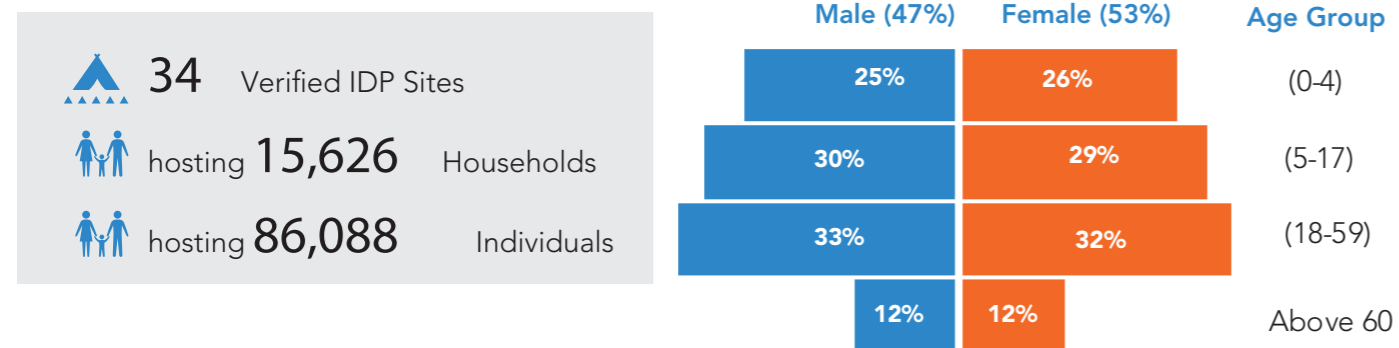
Map of verified IDP sites in Cabudwaaq - July 2024

CCCM cluster partners conducted an IDP site verification exercise in Cabudwaaq in July 2024 led by the local authority GCRI, UNHCR, Africa for Rural Development, GECPD, NoFYL, SCI, SPL and SSWC. 34 IDP sites were identified hosting 15,626 households or 86,088 individuals.

Compared to the last site verification conducted in December 2022, there was an decrease of 1,287 Households or 12,816 individuals. The number of sites decreased by 3.

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed to determine their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

44% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme and high risk of eviction

- 85%** of sites are communal/permanent ownership
- 64%** of sites have no agreements in place
- 83%** of those that have agreements have written agreements
- 17%** of those that have agreements have agreed end dates
- 41%** of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

1 IDP sites (3%) has been classified as having extreme risk of flooding (always floods)
