

## Monthly Work Permit Report- April 2024

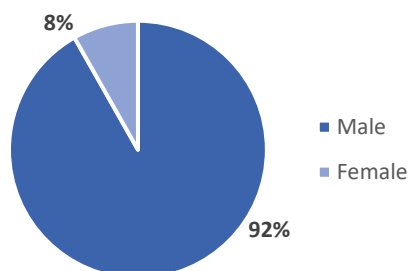
The Zaatari Office for Employment (ZOE) is operated by the Syrian Refugees Affairs Directorate (SRAD), the Ministry of Labor, UNHCR (UN Refugee Agency), and the International Labour Organization. It facilitates access to formal employment outside the camp through issuing work permits (WP).



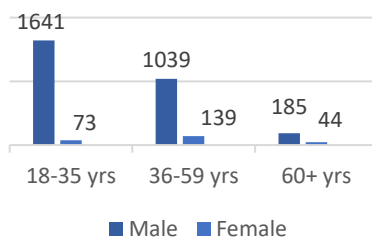
### Key Figures:

- **27,597** WPs have been issued since the establishment of the ZOE in 2017.
- **34,836** refugees (18+) in the camp are eligible for work.
- **9 percent** of those with work permits are active cases.
- **3,121** are active refugee work permit holders.
- In April **2024**, **37** WPs were renewed (**34** Males and **3** females), while **1** WP was issued.

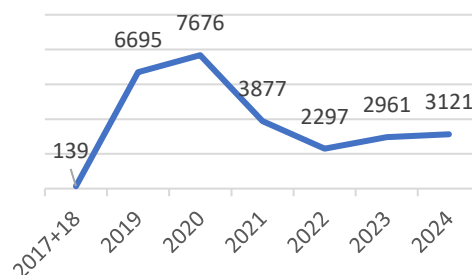
### WP By Gender



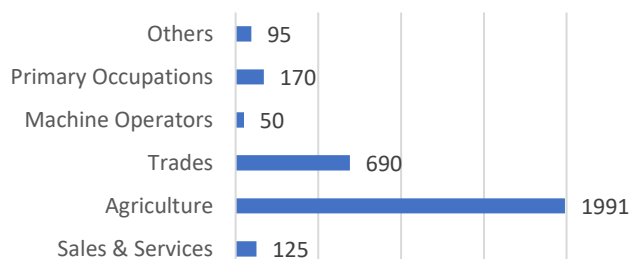
### WP Holders (Gender & Age)



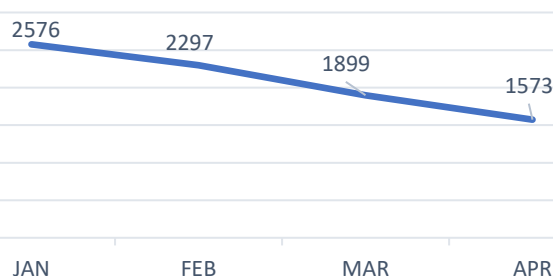
### The number of WP issued

### Activities:

- The Estidama++ project will cover the expense of the WPs and the Social Security contribution once registered to the system.
- The refugee who wants to obtain FWP should be at the GFJTU office.
- The GFJTU has increased the fees of WP to 60 JODs.
