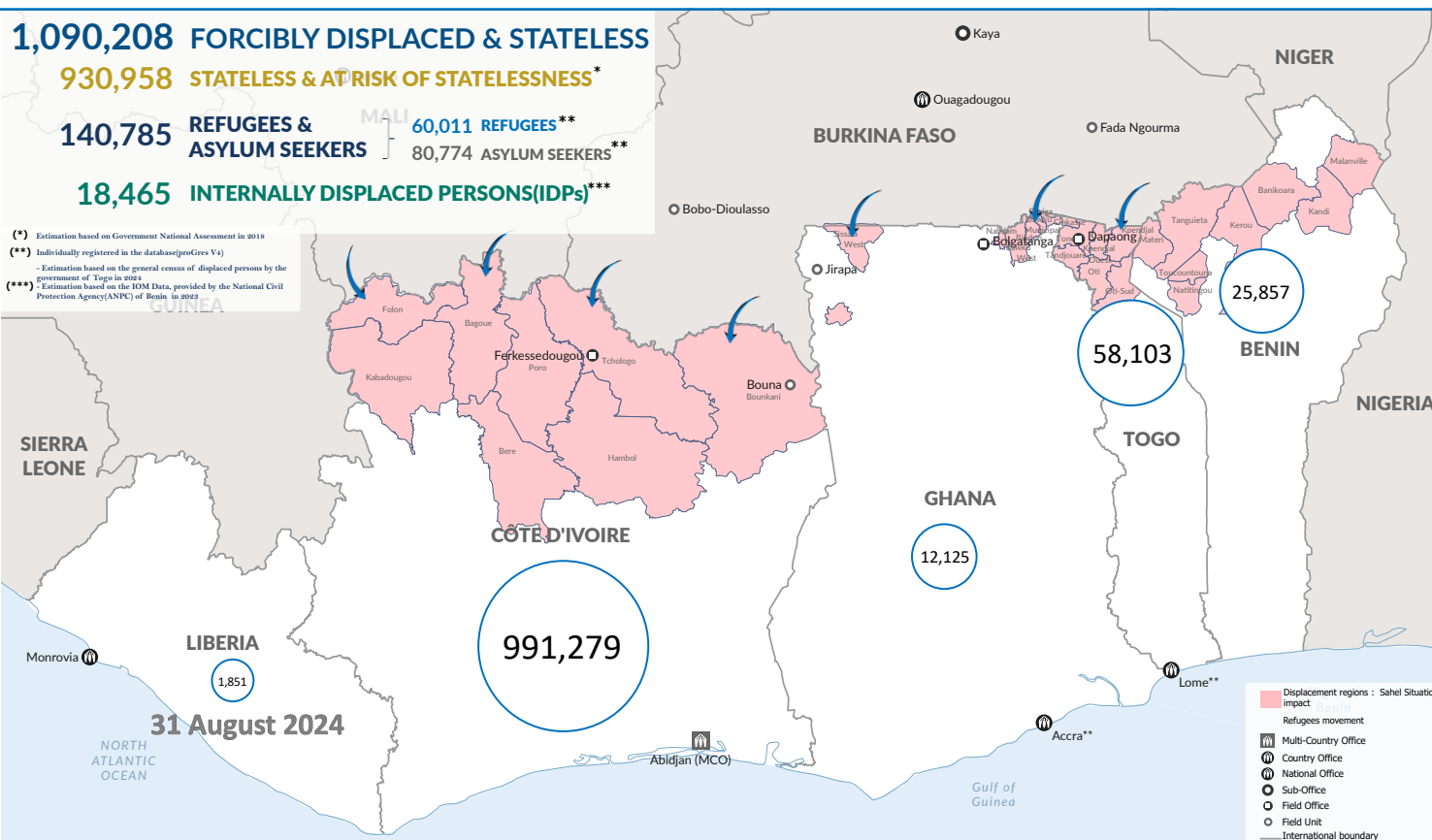

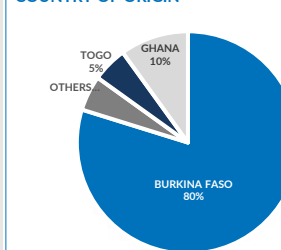

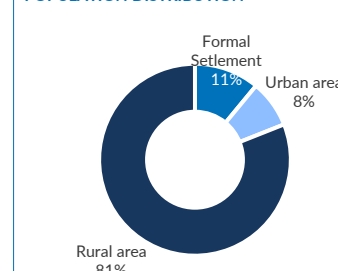

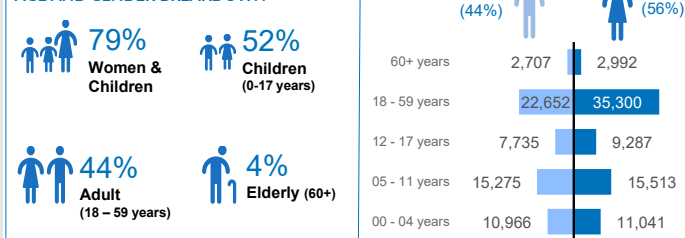
**COUNTRY OF ORIGIN**



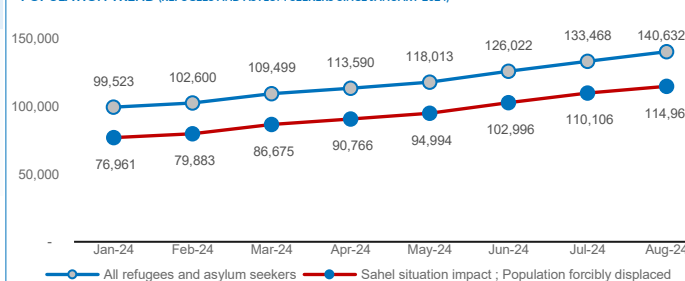
**POPULATION DISTRIBUTION**

**ANALYSIS OVERVIEW**

The current number of 140 thousands refugees and asylum seekers represent an increase of 34% of the total number of refugees and asylum seekers individually registered since January 2024. Coastal countries (Benin, Côte d'Ivoire, Ghana and Togo) are affected by forced displacement because of the ongoing situation of conflict in the Sahel. New arrivals in these countries started in April 2021 and became more frequent since January 2023.

A total of 44% of refugee and asylum seekers are hosted in Cote d'Ivoire, 34% are hosted in Togo and 12% are hosted in Benin. More than 64% of refugees and asylum seekers come from Burkina Faso. As the registration process is ongoing, a total of 140,785 individuals are already registered biometrically and represent 80% of the total new arrivals (175,506), the remaining figure (34,721 individuals) are asylum seekers preregistered and awaiting individual registration in Benin, Cote d'Ivoire, Togo and Ghana and represent 20% of the total new arrivals.

18,465 of forcibly displaced persons are internally displaced in their countries (Benin and Togo)
