



Mixed Movements Response

January – September 2024

In the reporting period, **263,296 refugees and migrants** crossed the Darien jungle in search of protection and better opportunities – **36 per cent less** than in the same period of 2023. Most come from Venezuela, Ecuador, Colombia, and Haiti.* Many come from as far as China, India, and Afghanistan.

UNHCR, national authorities, and partners respond to protection, gender-based violence, health, shelter, and legal needs of refugees and migrants and support transit and host communities in **Darien and Chiriqui**.

People received counseling and legal assistance related to Panama’s asylum system

People supported with mental health and psychosocial support services (MHPSS), including safe spaces

Officials trained in international protection and statelessness
