

Monthly Work Permit Report- September 2024

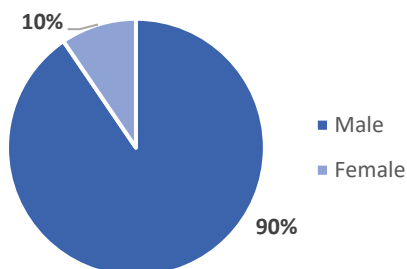
The Zaatari Office for Employment (ZOE) is operated by the Syrian Refugees Affairs Directorate (SRAD), the Ministry of Labor, UNHCR (UN Refugee Agency), and the International Labour Organization. It facilitates access to formal employment outside the camp through issuing work permits (WP).



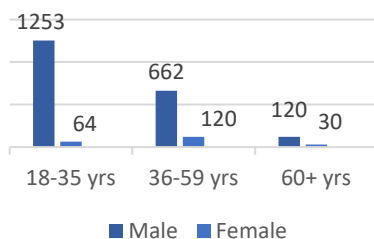
Key Figures:

- **28,401** WPs have been issued since the establishment of the ZOE in 2017.
- **34,620** refugees (18+) in the camp are eligible for work.
- **6.5 percent** of those with work permits are active cases.
- Until the first of September, **2,249** are active refugee work permit holders.
- In September **2024**, **0** WPs were renewed or issued.

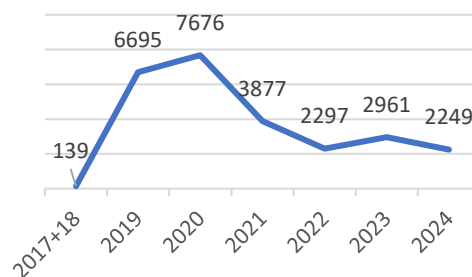
WP By Gender



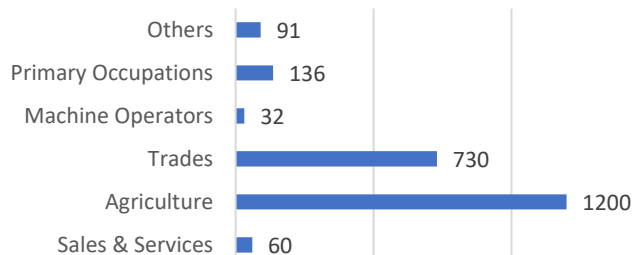
WP Holders (Gender & Age)



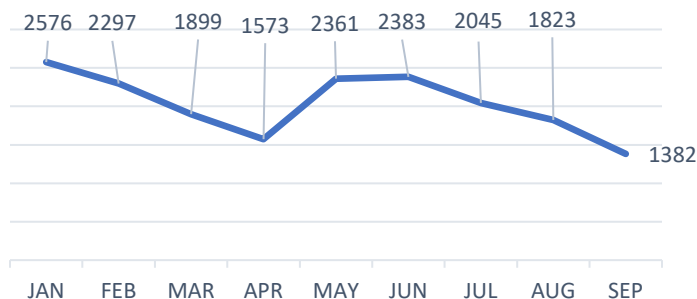
The number of WP issued

Comments:

- The new government regulation, which will drop the number of WPs in the camp, increased the Work Permit (WP) fees to **425 JODs** and **85 JODs** for medical tests. Depending on the type of flexible WP, the refugee should pay **50 JODs** for the GFJTU or **13 JODs** for the agriculture cooperatives.
- Social Security contribution stays as is (**58 JODs/month**).
