**OPERATIONAL CONTEXT**

As of September 30, 2024, the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) had more than half a million refugees, totaling 523,365, primarily from the Central African Republic, Rwanda, South Sudan, and Burundi.

The UNHCR operation in the DRC considers resettlement and complementary pathways as part of its protection and durable solutions strategy. Resettlement remains the most appropriate solution for refugees who cannot return to their country of origin and have acute protection needs in the host country. The operation estimates that more than 79,808 refugees in the DRC need to be resettled. Since the end of 2022, more than 2,000 people have been identified and processed for resettlement.

To date, 88 individuals have been submitted to resettlement countries: 83 to the USA, 2 to France, and 3 to Canada. 431 refugees have been resettled in the USA. Protection needs assessments for refugees continue in the field in more than ten settlement areas to determine their eligibility for resettlement and complementary pathways.

The operation has also coordinated and provided logistical support for Circuit Rides (missions of the United States Government and its partners) for more than 550 refugees in 2023 (of which 431 people have departed to the United States by the end of August 2024), and for approximately 650 refugees in 2024.

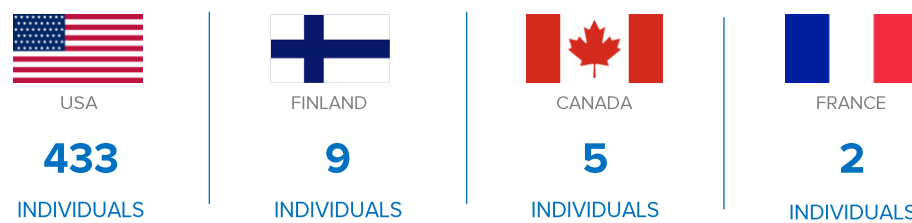
**CHALLENGES**

- No dedicated staff for resettlement in the field;
- Insecurity and remoteness of refugee sites;
- Quality data issues in proGres due to prima facie recognition (family composition);
- High logistical costs for organizing Circuit Rides;

**PRIORITIES UNTIL THE END OF THE YEAR**

- Continue submissions under the USA quota and the unallocated global quota;
- Continue case profiling and holding RST Panel sessions;
- Organize capacity-building sessions for UNHCR staff and partners in Kinshasa;
- Provide logistical support for organizing pre-screening missions of the USA partner in Aru and Gbadolite;

**COUNTRY OF RESETTLEMENT 2022 - 2024**



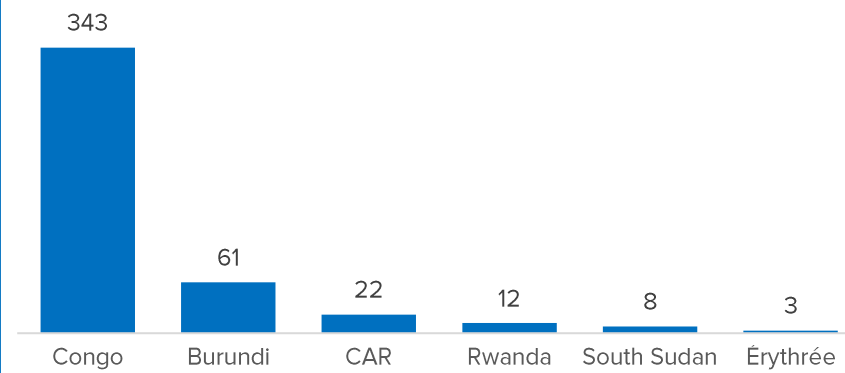

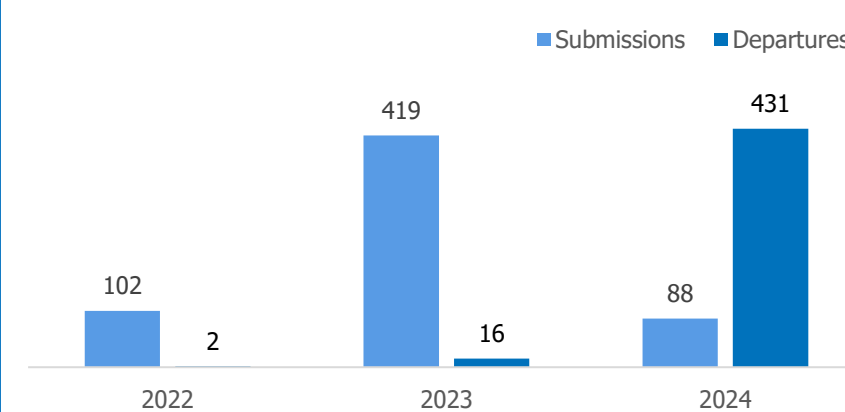

**PEOPLE RESETTLED FROM 2022 - 2024**



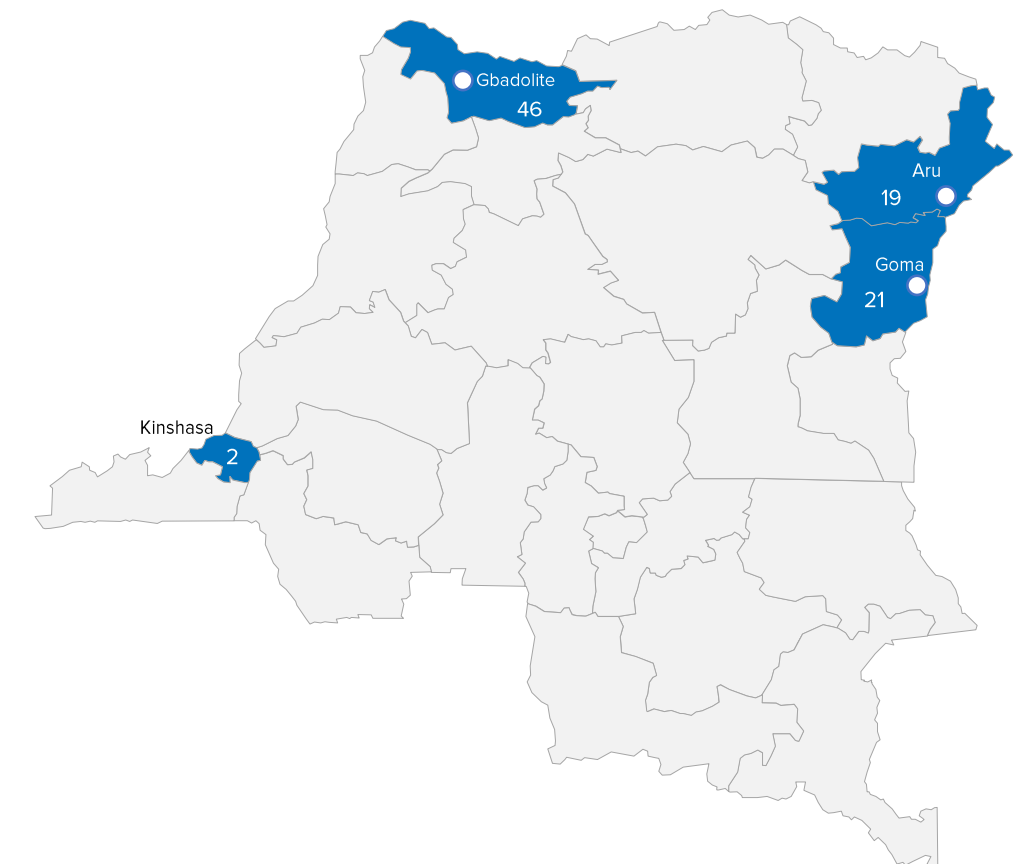
**RST SUBMISSIONS AND DEPARTURES SINCE 2022**
