


SITUATION OVERVIEW



- During the last 24 hours, **68** airstrikes were recorded on various areas of Lebanon, mostly concentrated in the south and Nabatiyeh, bringing the total number of attacks since the beginning of the aggression to **11,647**.
- The **Ministry of Public Health** issued the toll of martyrs and wounded during the last 24 hours, where **45** martyrs and **110** wounded were recorded, bringing the total number since the start of the aggression to **2,865** martyrs and **13,047** wounded.
- The **Public Health Emergency Operations Center of the Ministry of Public Health** issued statements announcing that the Israeli enemy raids today led to the death of 6 paramedics and the injury of 4 others, bringing the total number of martyrs of paramedics since the beginning of the aggression to **178**, the number of wounded to **279** and the number of targeted vehicles to **246**.
- The **Minister of Public Health** announced the toll of attacks on hospitals since the beginning of the aggression, where **55** attacks on hospitals were recorded, including **36** direct targeting of hospitals, which led to the forced closure of **8** hospitals and partial work in **7** hospitals.
- To date, **1,130** accredited shelters have been opened to accommodate and receive IDPs, and the number of accredited shelters has reached a maximum capacity of **948**.
- The total number of registered IDPs reached **189,174** IDPs in approved shelters (**43,766** families), with the highest percentage of IDPs recorded in Mount Lebanon Governorate and Beirut, but the number of IDPs is estimated to be much higher.
- From September 23 to October 30, 2024, **General Security** recorded the crossing of **358,133** Syrian citizens and **172,604** Lebanese citizens into Syrian territory.
- The **Government's Emergency Committee** receives international aid and distributes it to displaced people within a clear and transparent mechanism across governorates.
- The **National Committee for the Coordination of Crisis Response** is working with all relevant ministries to secure additional shelters in various governorates to receive the displaced.
- All **security agencies** maintain security, contribute to assisting the displaced, distributing food and fuel, protecting shelters, preventing monopolies, controlling prices, and monitoring and controlling borders.
- The **Army** issued that on 30/10/2024, an Italian plane carrying humanitarian aid donated by the Order of Malta - Lebanon and the Military Technical Committee for Lebanon arrived at Rafic Hariri International Airport in Beirut.
- The **Ministry of Agriculture** issued that the agricultural damage resulting from the aggression, which was initially limited to 56 border towns, and after the expansion of the aggression starting from mid-September, the circle of destruction of the components of the sector expanded until it exceeded the entire governorates of the south and Nabatiyeh to include the largest Lebanese governorates, including Baalbek-Hermel, which constitutes **27** percent of Lebanon's area.
- Two aircraft of the **Qatari Air Force** arrived today at Beirut airport, carrying **52** tons of aid and provided by the State of Qatar to Lebanon.

FREQUENCY OF ATTACKS ON LEBANON IN THE PAST 24 HOURS





Number of attacks per region in the last 24 hours




Number of attacks per Casa since the beginning of aggression




MOVEMENT OF INTERNAL DISPLACEMENT


The number of IDPs registered in shelters identified by the National Operations Room has reached **189,174** IDPs so far, according to the National Platform.



Number of IDPs Per Governorate




Distribution of Shelters per Governorate
