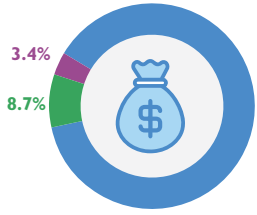

January - September 2024 Sector Funding Status

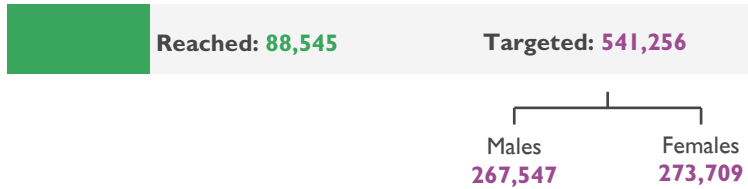
