



Lebanon Basic Assistance Sector: At a Glance

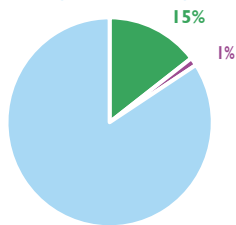
September 2024

The Basic Assistance sector in Lebanon is working to: OUTCOME 1) Strengthen the ability of poor and vulnerable households and individuals, including female-headed HHs, persons with disabilities and children, to meet their basic needs ; OUTCOME 2) strengthen the ability of populations affected by seasonal hazards and emergencies to secure additional basic needs; OUTCOME 3) Technical assistance to the national social assistance system is provided;

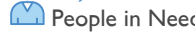
