

## UN REFUGEE RESPONSE COORDINATION IN ROMANIA

#### 1. Updates - Inter-Agency

The Refugee Response Plan (RRP) was [launched](#) on the 15th of January in Geneva. The RRP Romania will be launched probably in the second part of February. The idea of establishing a working group focused on social cohesion is under discussion. Overall, the conversation revolves around addressing the existing challenges in refugee support in the planning for 2024 – focus on potential solutions, for instance more collaboration and establishing roles around the advocacy efforts.

#### 2. Discussion on YAD TF - 2024

It was a challenging year, we had to adapt and work together more.

Some benefits of YAD TF in 2023:

- Information sharing and better understanding of what each organization is doing
- Platform for collaboration between organizations
- Collaborating we have reached more teenagers than we could do alone.
- The advocacy points shared in the Inter-Agency brought youth into attention of different stakeholders, including ministries.
- RRP2024 contains priorities on YAD due to collective contributions

Some shortcomings of YAD TF in 2023:

- Competition on resources and same YAD group
- Difficulty to reach and then keep YAD engaged
- Lack of participation of public authorities representatives in the meetings

Possible ways forward in 2024:

- Collaborating further – on specific objectives (events, topics, coordinating with specific roles for every meeting etc.); on common milestones.
- Narrowing down the advocacy points, advocating for them together and individually and discussing milestones in the YAD TF meetings

- More push on synchronising with public authorities on milestones
- Monthly reports are important for visibility of the needs in this area of work.
  - o Facilitating the way of sending monthly reports – maybe a template on the sharepoint that everyone can complete and rechecking access on the sharepoint (some members say they cannot access it)
- Mobilize recourses for common nation-wide events/days for a common, complementary approach – proposal to start a template and calendar for events in 2024.
- Participation of adolescents – for example by using U-Report Europe tool to gather opinions & needs of Ukrainian youth – dissemination of the tool, work on polls, using results as basis for programmes and advocacy

### 3. U-Report MHPSS poll

- The [poll on mental health](#) disseminated with Ukrainian YAD is closed; the results can be seen online or in the document saved in the YAD TF sharepoint. The current poll is on [2024 needs](#).
- Some insights:
  - o Coping with Stress
    - the most common strategies involve social interactions; talking with friends (19) and family (14).
  - o Searching for Mental Health Information
    - Online Search: 18 respondents search online for topics related to mental health.
    - Professional Help: 10 look for specialists online, and 4 consult a therapist directly.
    - Peer and Experience-Based: 6 check with friends, and 16 learn from experience.
    - Inactive: 11 haven't thought about searching for such information.
  - o Perceived Support Needs for Teens
    - Counseling: One-on-one counseling is seen as the most needed support by 33 respondents.
    - Other Support: Group counseling (7), online helplines (6), peer support (3), school programs (2), and parenting programs (4) are less frequently identified needs.
- For Romanian members of organizations that are testing the poll: please always choose “other” and write “test”, so that test trials of the poll can be excluded from the analysis.

### 4. Status updates & other

In the following months:

- RAA will focus on education, on mentoring and collaboration with DofE on preparing adolescents for employability.
- FNT activity at the Youth Centers will include workshops with 3D printer, financing small initiatives of adolescents and youth
- FNT will organize a [workshop](#) for active volunteers promoting U-Report tool between 9-11 February
