

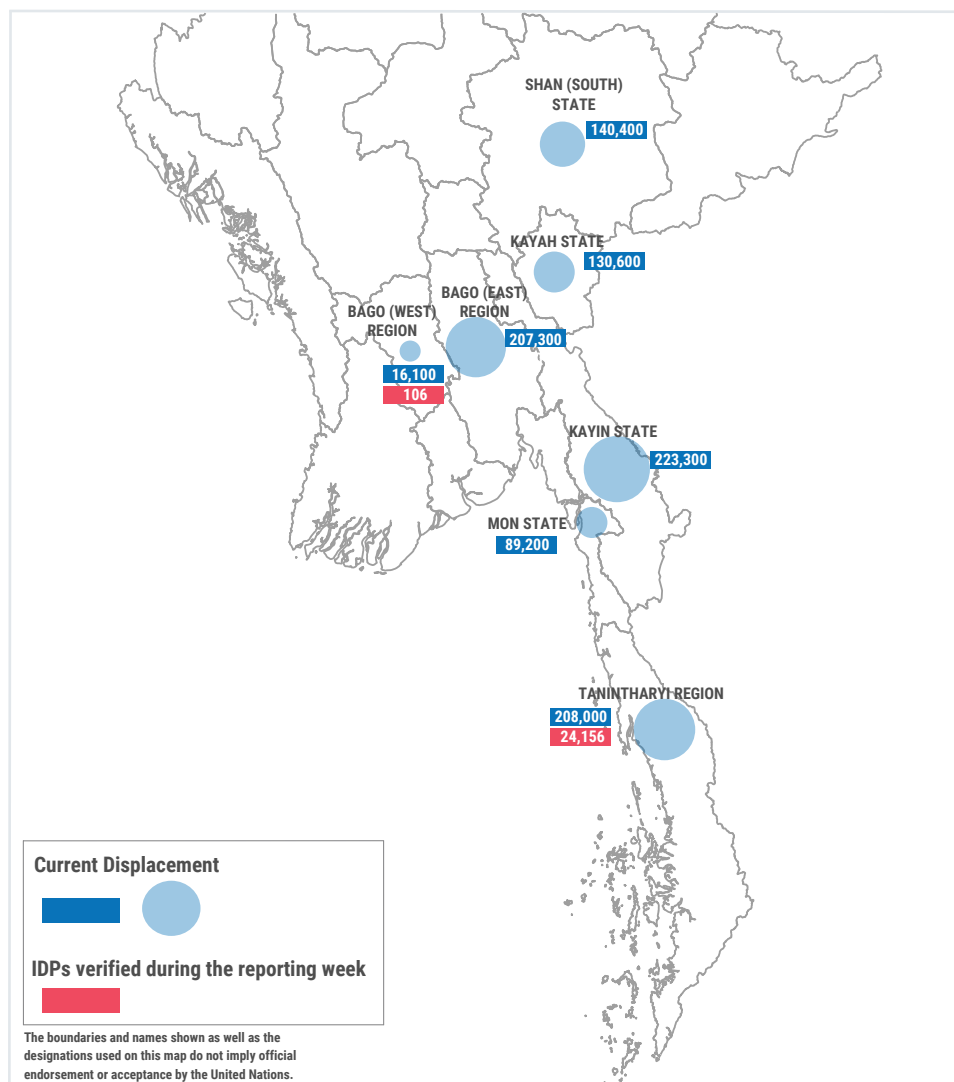
WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) sharply increased from 994,300 last week to 1,014,900 this week.

The intensified fighting in Tanintharyi Region pushed the displacements in this reporting period. Drone strikes and troop reinforcement by the Tatmadaw forced, respectively, 7,892, 6,600, and 6,006 people to flee from Yebyu, Palaw, and Tanintharyi Townships – in these three cases, the displacement occurred within the same township of origin. Tanintharyi Township also witnessed a secondary displacement of 3,658 IDPs, followed by a drone attack.

In Bago Region (East), artillery shelling forced 72 people to flee from Yedashe Township within the same township, while 34 Kyaukkyi to Taungoo Town.

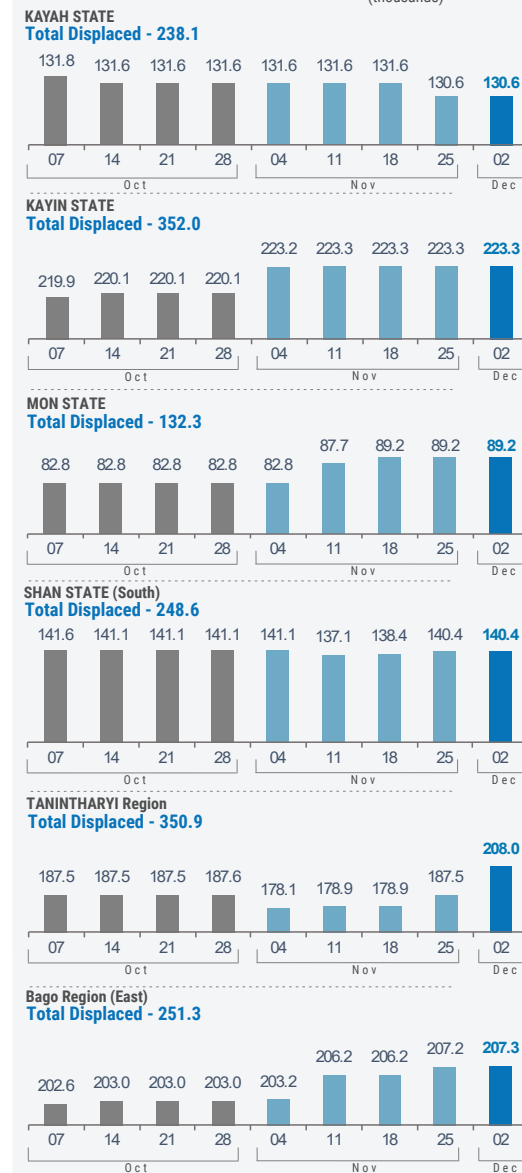
