

Syria governorates IDPs and IDP returnees overview

As of 09 February 2025

Key Figures

In Syria, an estimated **7.4 million individuals** remain internally displaced (IDPs), residing both within communities and in IDP sites. Of the total IDP population, **5.1 million** are estimated to be living outside IDP sites, while **2.3 million** reside in **1,750 IDP** sites, primarily in Northwest Syria (NWS). However, **recent events since November 27, 2024**, have triggered further displacement, with over **617,000 new IDPs recorded.**

At the same time, IDP returns continue, with 829,490 individuals reported to have returned home since November 27, 2024, including 80,993 returning from IDP sites since December 8, 2024.




% IDPs by governorate




IDP returnees age and gender breakdown






% IDP returnees by governorate
