

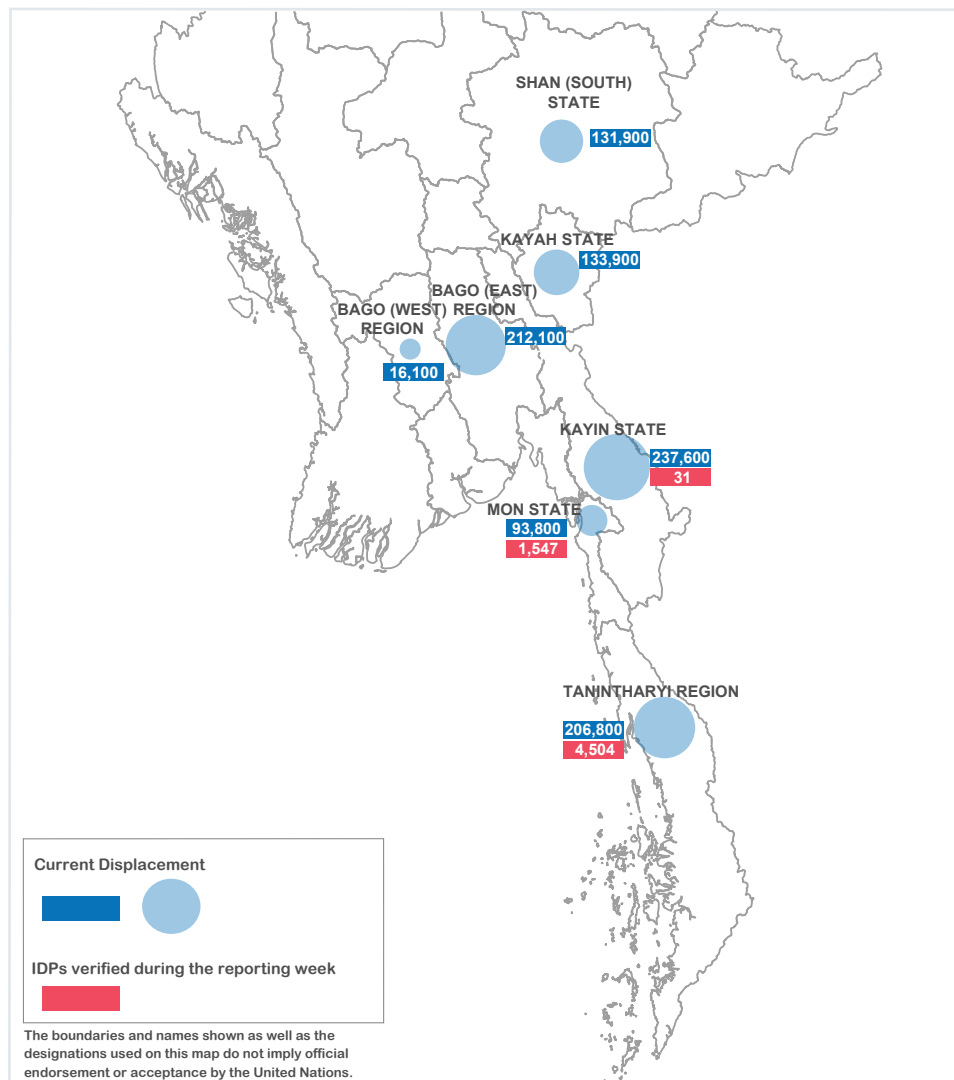
WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people decreased from 1,044,400 last week to 1,032,200 this week. In Kayin State, 31 people from Ka Taing Ti, Hpapun Township were displaced to Kamarmaung town due to the clashes.

In Mon State, 1,542 people from Ah Su Chaung and Pi Ti villages in Bilin Township were displaced within the same township due to intensified fighting.

In Tanintharyi Region, some 2,900 people from Shin Mote Ti village in Dawei Township were displaced within the same township, and 1,612 people from Kin Shay village in Thayetchaung Township were displaced within the same township due to a reinforcement of troops by the Tatmadaw. Meanwhile, 12,600 IDPs from Yebyu Township and 5,634 IDPs from Thayetchaung Township returned to their places of origin.

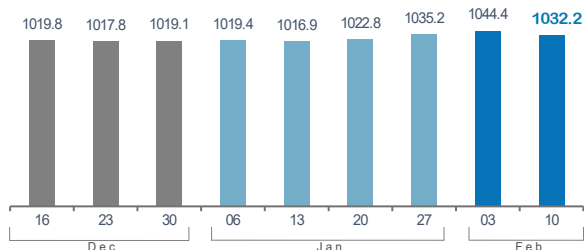

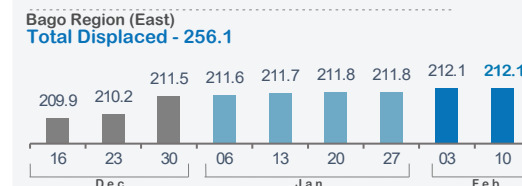
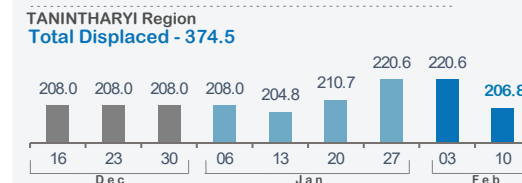
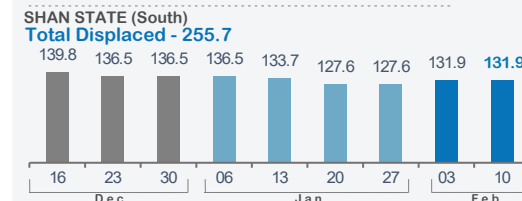
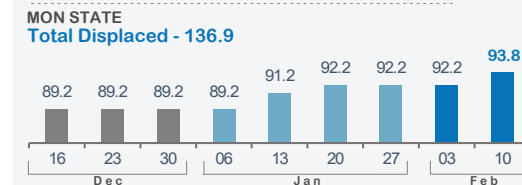
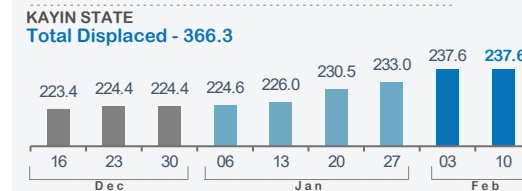
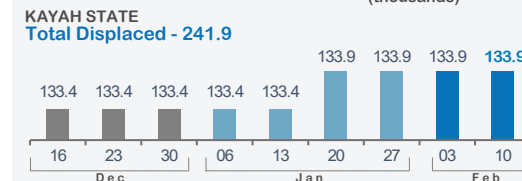
