26,545 individuals provided with individual legal counseling

523,972 individuals provided with information on rights and services available for refugees in a language of their choice

RRP 2024 achievements – Child Protection

16,990 children supported with specialized child protection services (e.g., family reunification and/or alternative care arrangements for unaccompanied and separated children)

6,738 children assisted with individual case management



1,400 unaccompanied and separated children in need provided with alternative care

59,497 children assisted in other safe places, protection and support hubs

6,865 participants trained on child protection and children's right

RRP 2024 achievements – Gender Based Violence



- **11,024** individuals benefited from GBV Specialized Programming
- **198,094** persons participating in community awareness sessions aimed at preventing or mitigating GBV risks
- **3,059** persons participating in empowerment and life skill sessions/ initiatives for women and adolescent girls

- 276 Police and Border Guard officers participated in counter trafficking trainings

- ✓ Protection advocacy interventions
- ✓ Engagement with government counterparts to propose meaningful solutions for refugees and access to rights
- ✓ Protection coordination/information sharing and capacity building among all protection actors
- ✓ Information provision
- ✓ Promotion of meaningful access to national systems for refugees by enhancing and contextualizing referral pathways at local and regional levels
- ✓ Strengthening national capacities and referral mechanisms regarding legal, Child Protection and GBV
- ✓ Joint capacity enhancement initiatives on protection, legal/asylum law, Child Protection and GBV
- ✓ Awareness raising on protection, Child Protection and GBV
