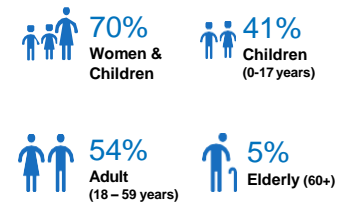

AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN

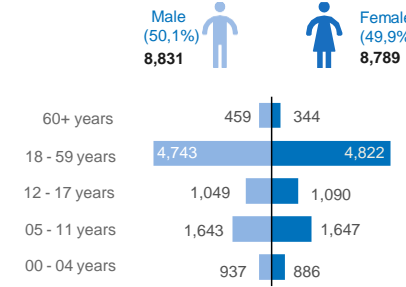

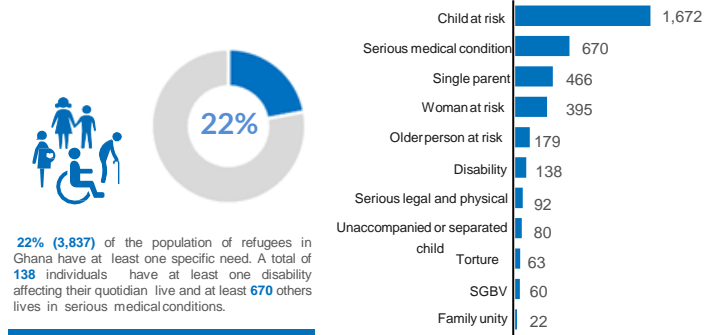

POPULATION BREAKDOWN AGE/GENDER*

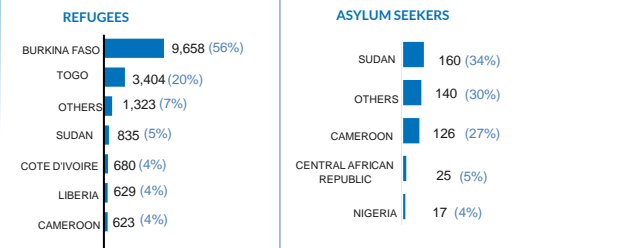

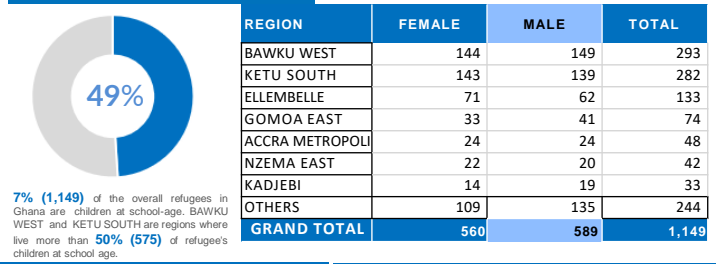

COUNTRY OF ORIGIN

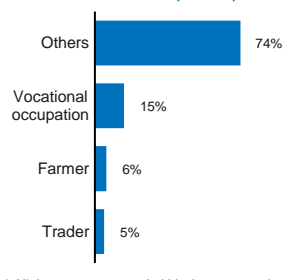


CHILDREN AT SCHOOL AGE BY REGION

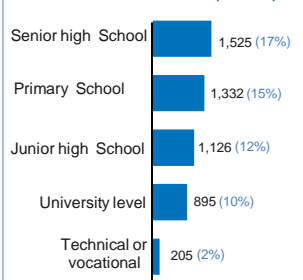

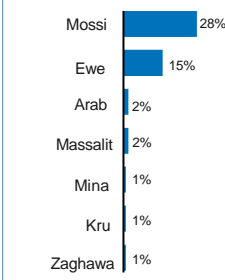
MAIN OCCUPATION(ADULT)*



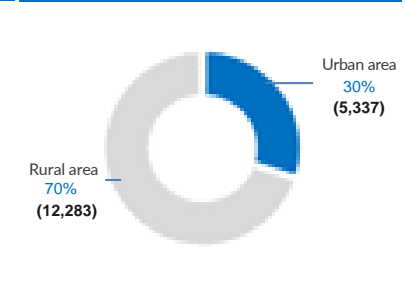
MAIN EDUCATION LEVEL (ADULT)



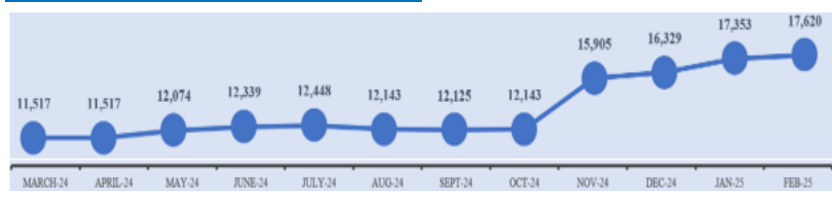
MAIN ETHNICITIES
