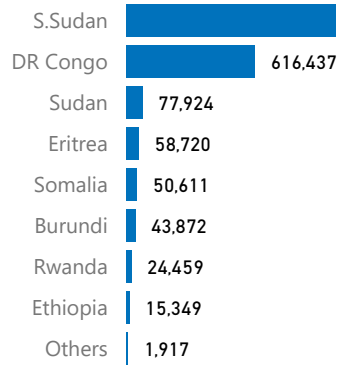

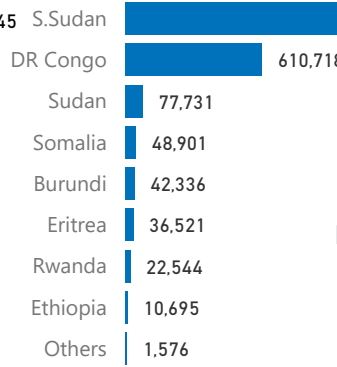

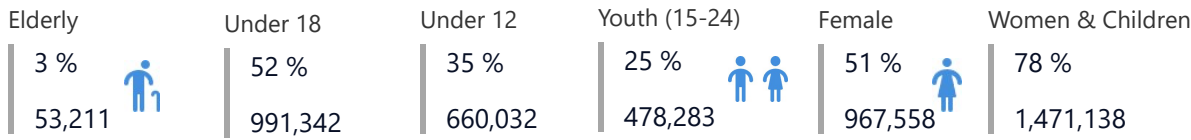
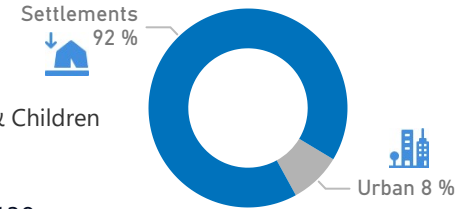
### Refugee Population



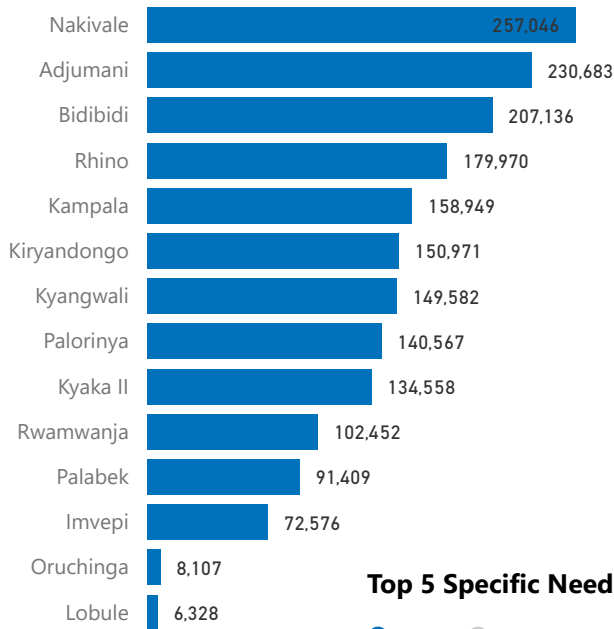

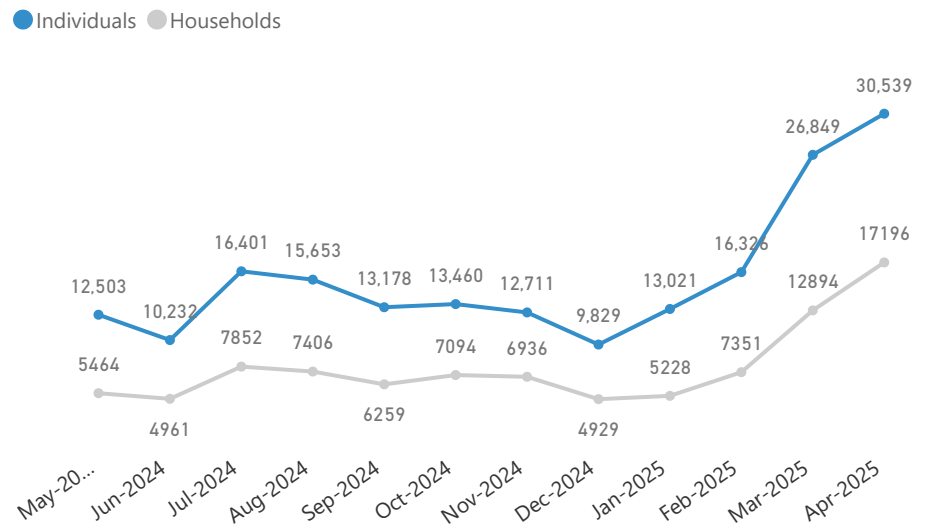
### Population Distribution



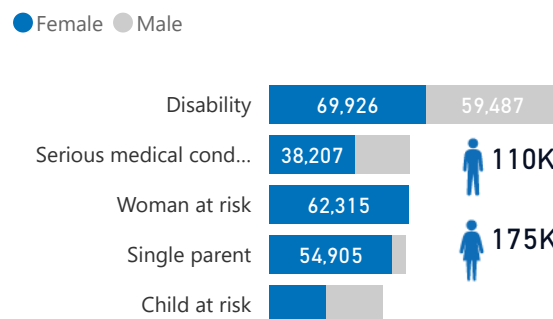
### Population by settlement



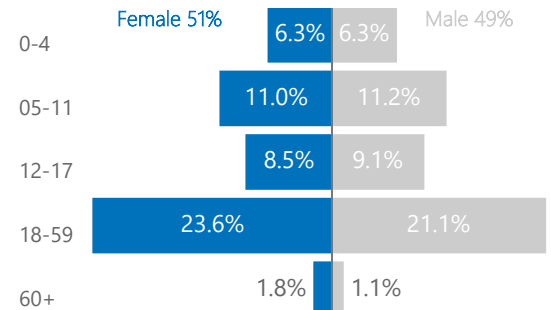

### Age & Gender Breakdown



Since the start of the year, 86,735 individuals seeking asylum, including 50,892 from the DR Congo, 21,337 from South Sudan, and 12,497 from Sudan have been registered in Uganda. 9,045 new births were also registered during the year. In total the population increased by 32,274 individuals (1.7%) from last month. Since the start of the conflict in Sudan in Mid-April 2023, 74,462 Sudanese fleeing the conflict have been registered in Uganda. Similarly, the situation in the DR Congo has resulted in increased arrivals into Uganda. There are currently 616,437 registered DR Congolese in Uganda, up 54,544 since end 2024.

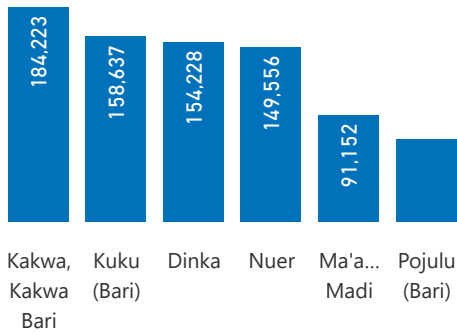

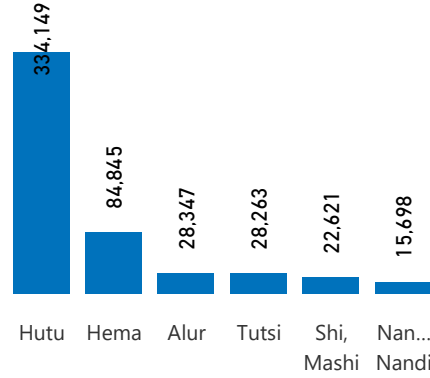

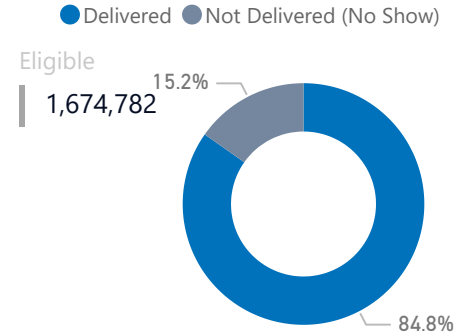
### Top South Sudanese Ethnicities



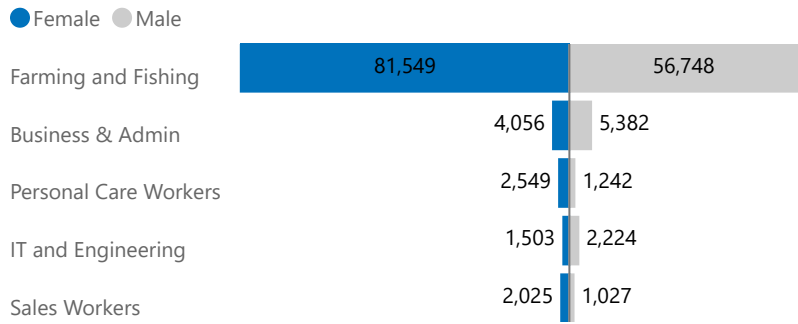

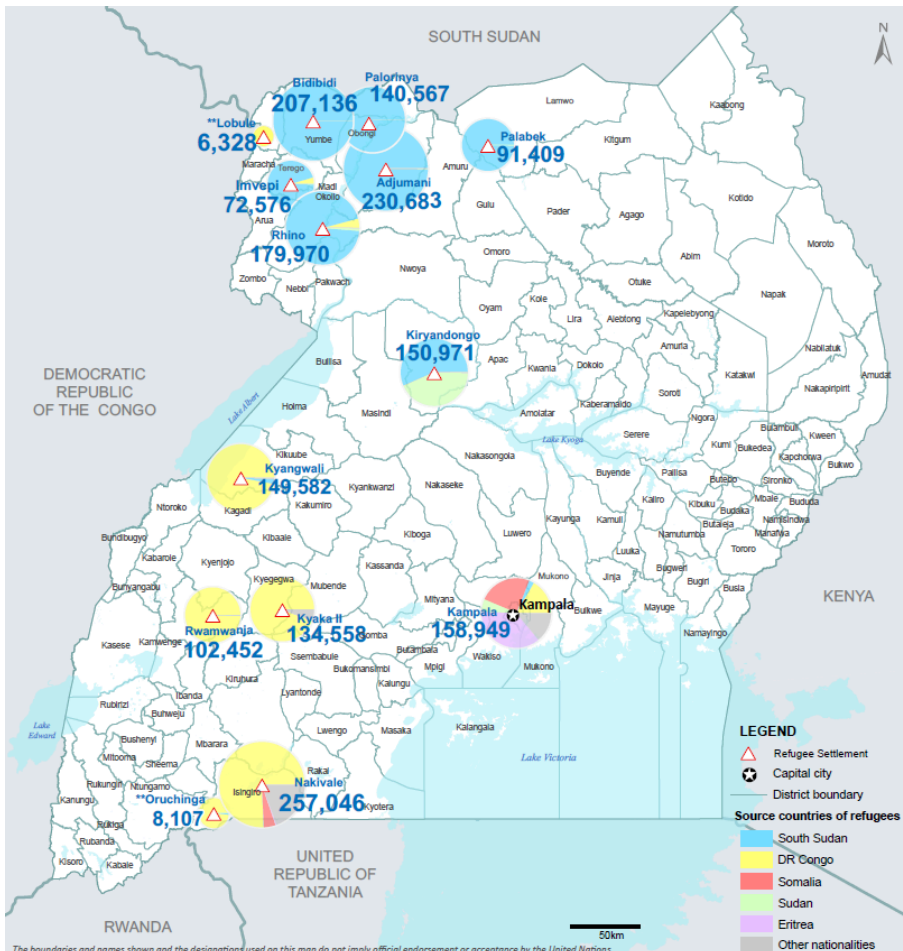
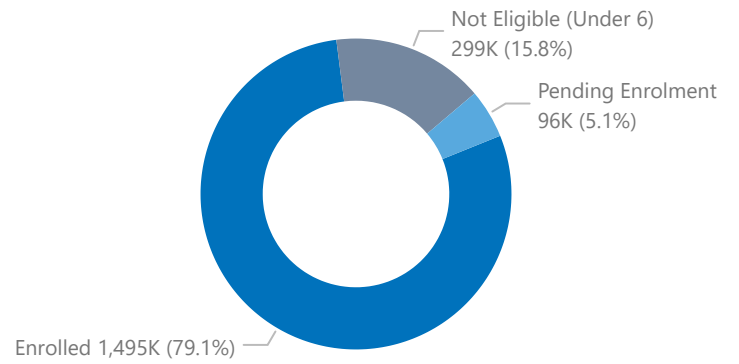
