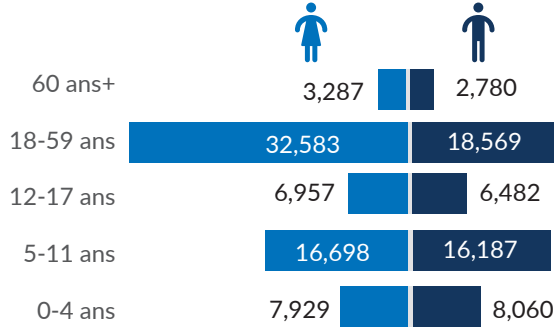
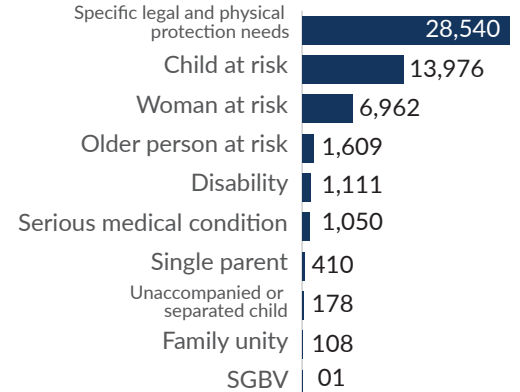
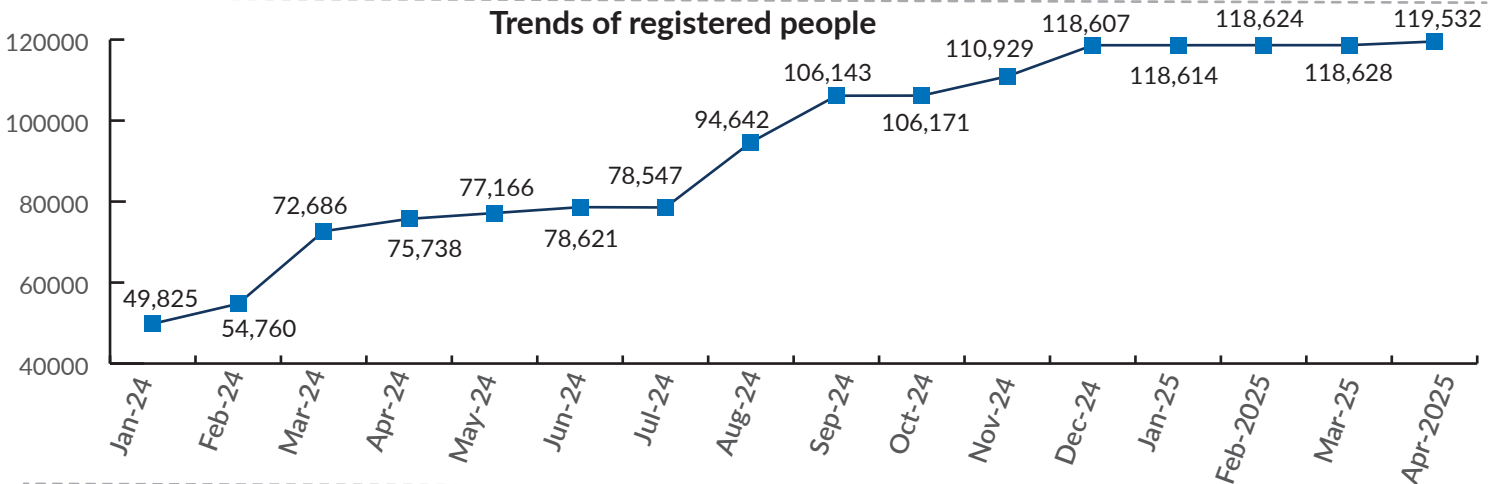
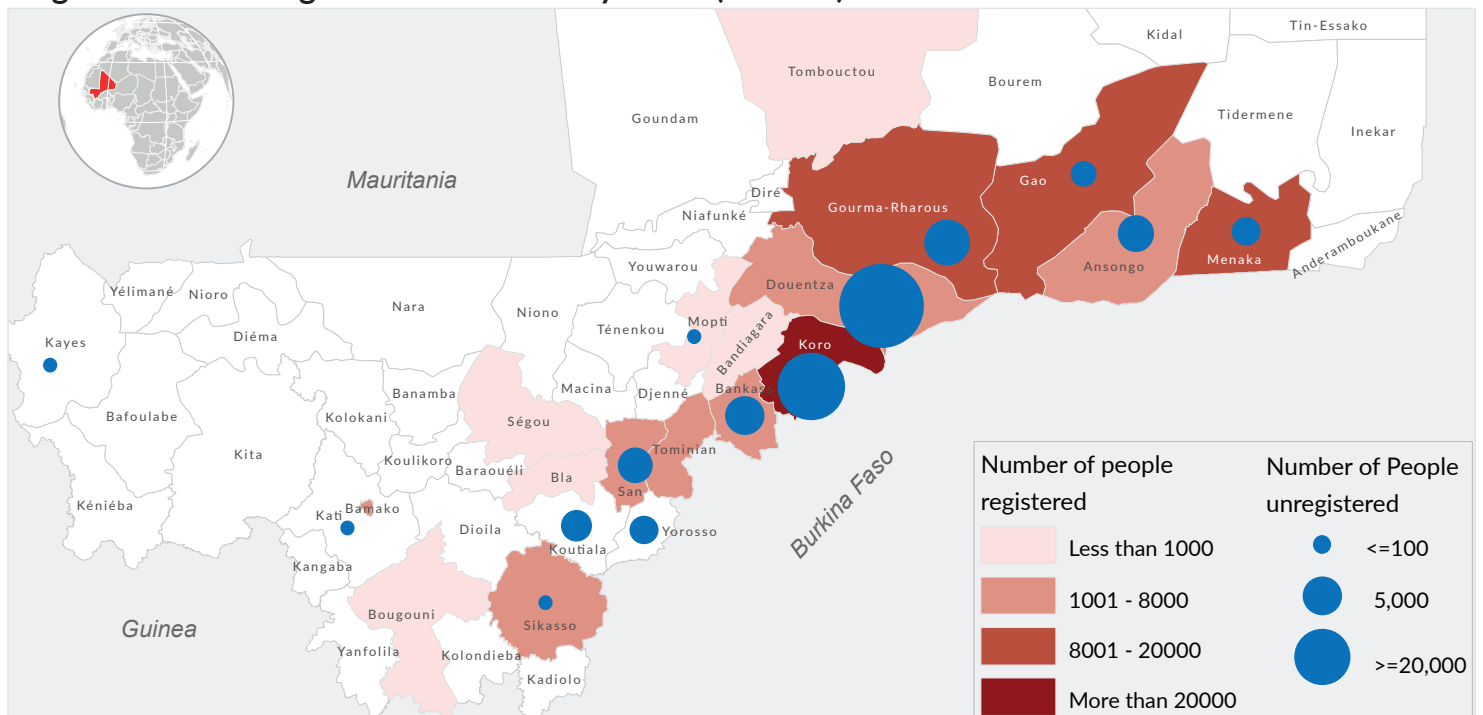

Mali is hosting around 120,000 Burkinabe and Nigeriens refugees. There has been a massive influx of refugees and asylum seekers from Burkina Faso (mainly from the Sahel region) and Niger. They are fleeing because of fear, insecurity and the effects of attacks and incursions by radical non-state armed groups, as well as military operations on the positions of armed groups. The majority of them have been registered during the registration activities jointly organized by the government and UNHCR in various areas where accessibility was granted. Among this population, there are more than 81,600 individuals remaining unregistered (78,000 burkinabe and 3,600 Nigeriens).
