

In June 2025, approx 17,000 new internal displacements were monitored by the UNHCR-led Protection and Solutions Monitoring Network (PSMN). Major drivers include floods (7,192 - 41%), conflict & insecurity (3,872 - 22%), drought (2,604 - 15%), and other reasons (3,919 - 22%).

Overall, in June 2025, PSMN recorded the highest number of internal displacement in **Garowe** (3,876). These displacements were caused by floods, the single highest cause for displacements in the month of June.

44,564 Refugees & Asylum-Seekers

At the end of June 2025, a total of 37,638 refugees and asylum-seekers are registered in Somalia, mainly from Ethiopia (29,209 asylum seekers and refugees), Yemen (12,736 refugees). The remaining 2,619 registered are from other countries.


Data presented in this report relates to returnees arriving in Somalia as of June 2025.

Since December 2014, a Total of **140,956** have returned in Somalia, UNHCR has supported **96,625** Somali refugees to return to Somalia. Additionally, a total of **44,331** Somalis were monitored as arriving spontaneously.


Somali returnees from Kenya by month



Assisted spontaneous returnees from Yemen by month





Returnees, refugee and asylum seekers map




Number of returnees (with assistance from UNHCR) by Year
