UNHCR's Multi-Country Office (MCO) in Panama provides strategic and operational support to forcibly displaced persons, stateless individuals, and other vulnerable populations across Central America and the Caribbean. In 2025, the office underwent a significant internal restructuring to enhance its regional response capacity. As a result, the MCO now covers 22 countries, with centralized oversight provided by a core multifunctional team based in Panama.
