The conflict in Sudan between the Sudanese Armed Forces and the Rapid Support Forces started on 15 April 2023. This dashboard gives an overview of arrivals and registration trends in Egypt since the onset of the conflict.

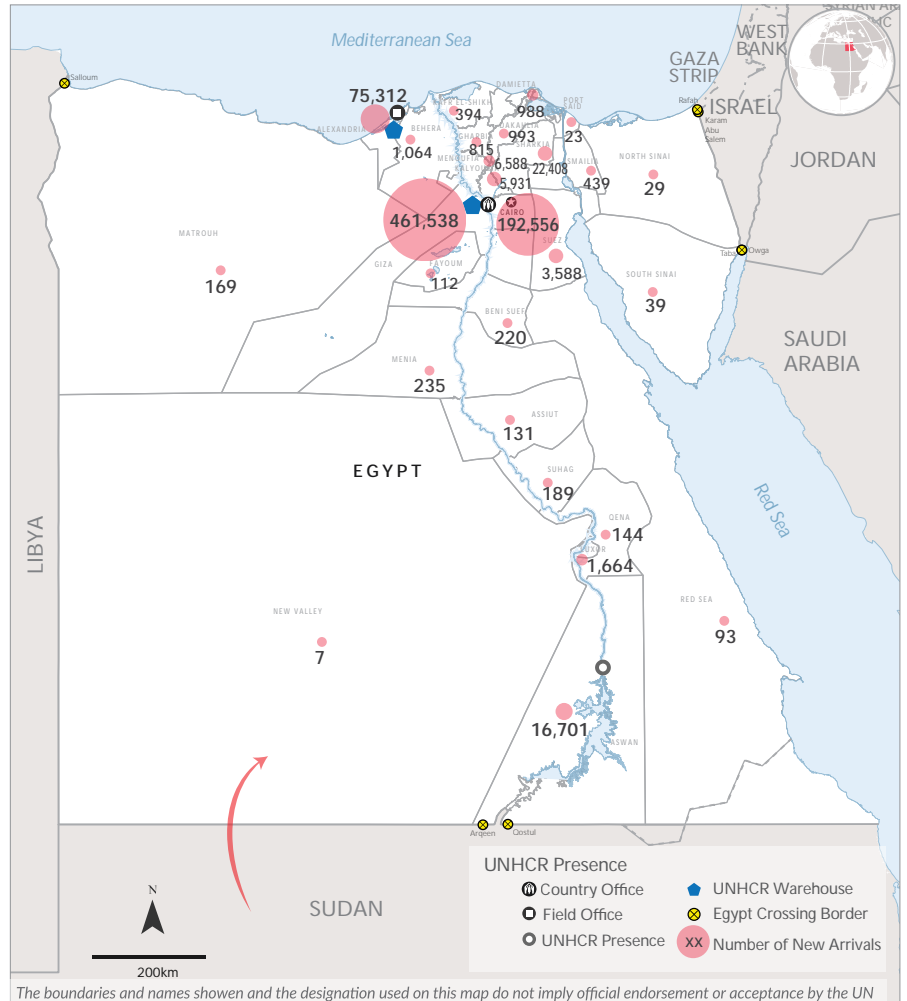
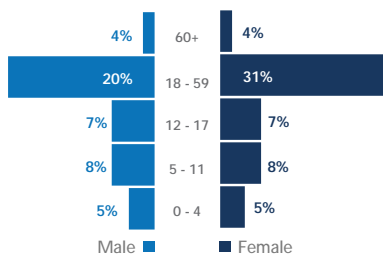
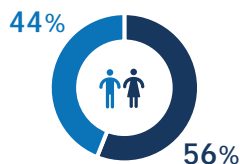
