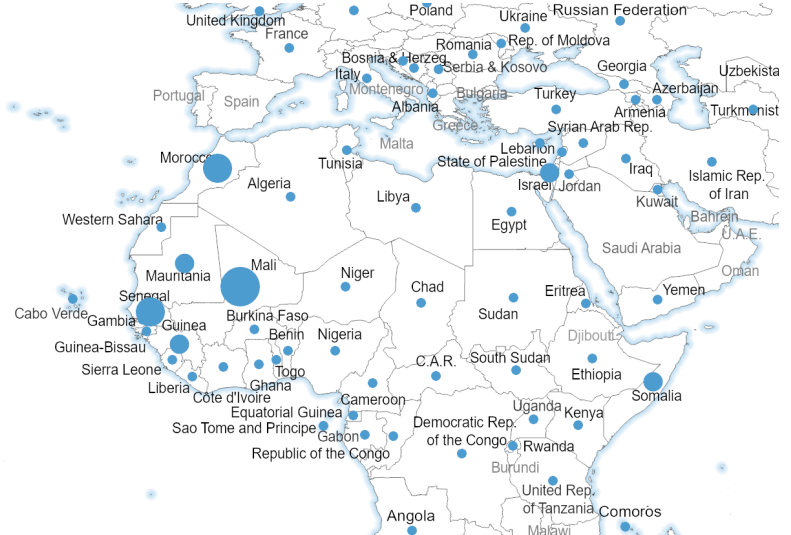
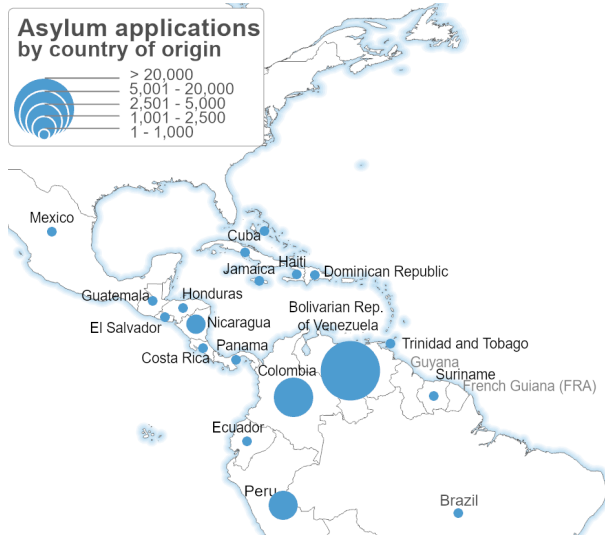

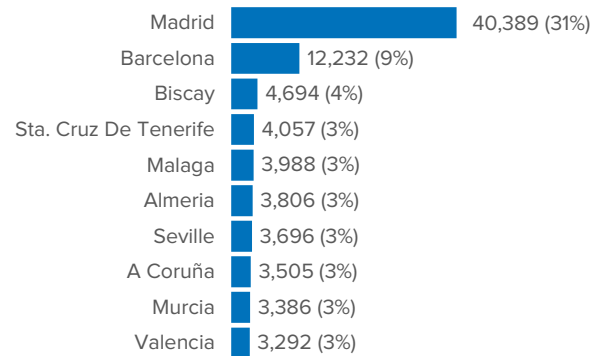
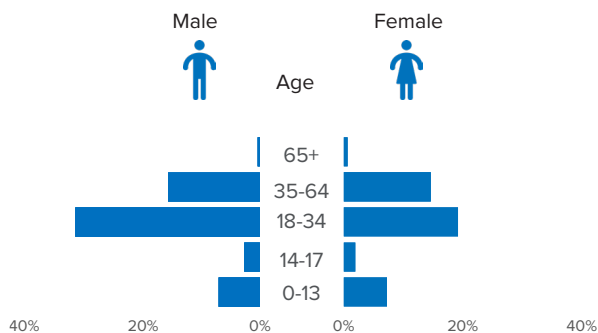

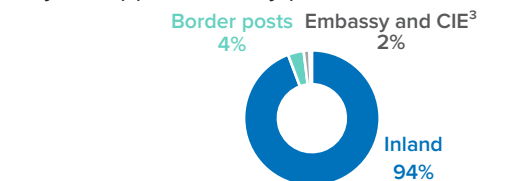
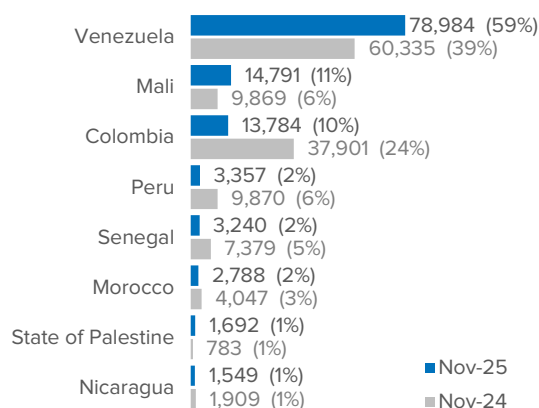
 Percentage of asylum applications by gender and age²

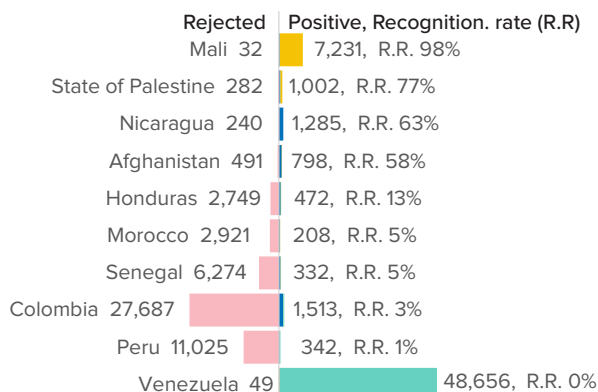

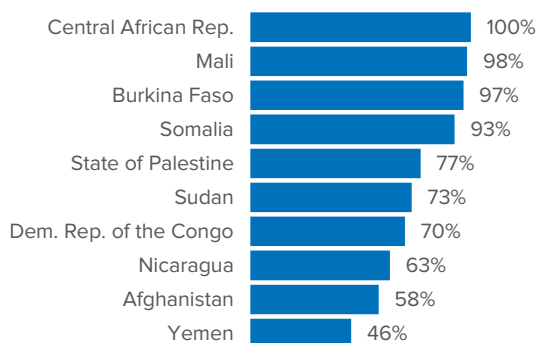

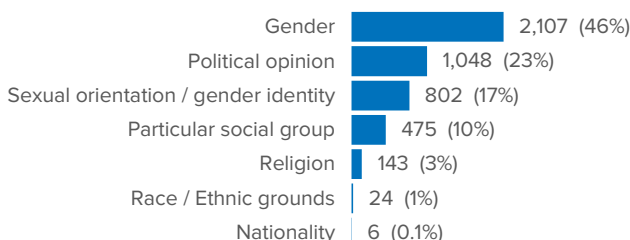

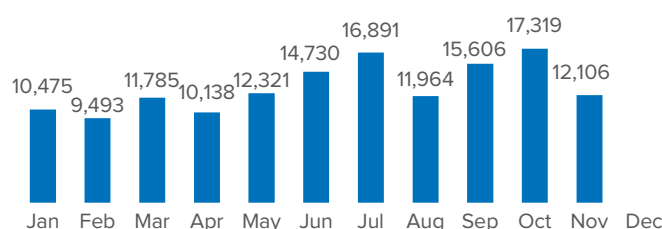
Countries with highest recognition rate⁵

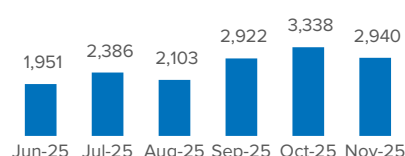

Applications (last six months)



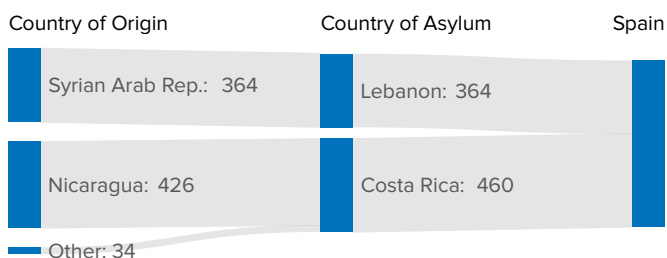

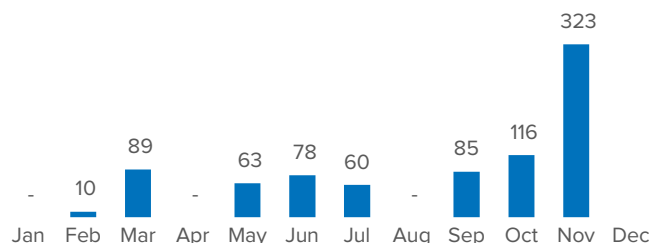
