

Contingency stock data are regularly updated on Activity Info by partners to support emergency preparedness, gap identification, and evidence-based advocacy. This snapshot reflects the latest information reported and provides an overview of available contingency stocks across LRP sectors in the Bekaa, Beirut and Mount Lebanon (BML), North, and South regions.<sup>1</sup>

## Situation Analysis

Current contingency stocks<sup>2</sup> across sectors provide partial coverage against planning assumptions under moderate escalation scenarios. However, notable shortages in WaSH, Protection, Education, and Food supplies are noted. Stocks are concentrated in Beirut/Mount Lebanon and the Bekaa, while needs are significant in high-risk areas such as North/Akkar and South/Nabatieh. While partners might be able to respond to localized shocks, existing pre-positioned supplies would be insufficient in the event of large-scale or protracted displacement or if access constraints delay replenishment, particularly in high-risk border areas.

**Bekaa:** High risk of rapid displacement due to proximity to border areas. Existing stocks allow for initial response only and would be quickly overstretched in mass influx scenarios. Gaps are most notable in shelter and WaSH supplies.

**Beirut and Mount Lebanon:** Likely to absorb secondary displacement. While partner presence is strong, storage capacity and collective shelter options are limited, which may constrain rapid scale-up.

**North:** High vulnerability and infrastructure fragility increase response complexity. Current stocks are insufficient for sustained displacement, particularly in remote areas.

**South:** Highest-risk area under current escalation scenarios. Available stocks would not meet needs in case of widespread displacement or infrastructure damage. Access and warehousing constraints remain key risks.
