Coordination Structure for Emergency Response to Internal Displacement in Lebanon

Note

Purpose:

- The coordination architecture ensures **effective collaboration between Government crisis-management structures and the humanitarian system under the LRP.**
- It aims to maintain **clear communication, aligned priorities, and efficient operational response** from national decision-making to governorate and municipal implementation.

Government Leadership:

- The emergency response is led by the **National Operations Room** under the **Disaster Risk Management (DRM) Unit at the Grand Serail.**
- The **Prime Minister designated the Ministry of Social Affairs (MoSA)** to coordinate the response with UN agencies and NGOs.
- **Governors and DRM focal points** coordinate response actions at the governorate level.

Humanitarian Coordination (LRP Architecture):

- **MoSA:** Government counterpart coordinating with humanitarian partners and channeling official requests.
- **Inter-Sector Coordination Group (ISCG):** Coordinates across sectors and serves as the main interface between Government and the humanitarian community.
- **Sectors:** Provide technical leadership, partner coordination, and response monitoring by thematic area.

Sub-National Operational Coordination:

- **Operational Coordination Groups (OCGs)** link national coordination with governorate-level response.
- OCGs coordinate with **Governors, DRM committees, local authorities, and operational partners** to implement the response and address local priorities.

Information Management & Reporting:

- **DRM dashboards consolidate national response data** from government entities and humanitarian partners.
- **LRP partners report daily through ActivityInfo**, enabling real-time tracking of needs and response.

Contingency Stocks

Reporting

- Sectors to remind partners that updating contingency stocks on [ActivityInfo](#) is a continuous exercise and does not have a fixed deadline. As stocks regularly move in and out, partners are expected to update their inventory on a routine basis whenever changes occur.
- Following recent distributions, **maintaining up-to-date and accurate contingency stock information is critical** for the emergency, as it allows for a clear overview of available resources and, accordingly, supports gap identification and evidence-based advocacy.

Contingency Stocks Snapshot

- High-level overview reflecting the latest information reported and provides a consolidated picture of available contingency stocks across LRP sectors in the Bekaa, Beirut and Mount Lebanon (BML), North, and South.
- Serve as a useful reference for preparedness discussions at all levels, particularly in light of the current regional escalation.

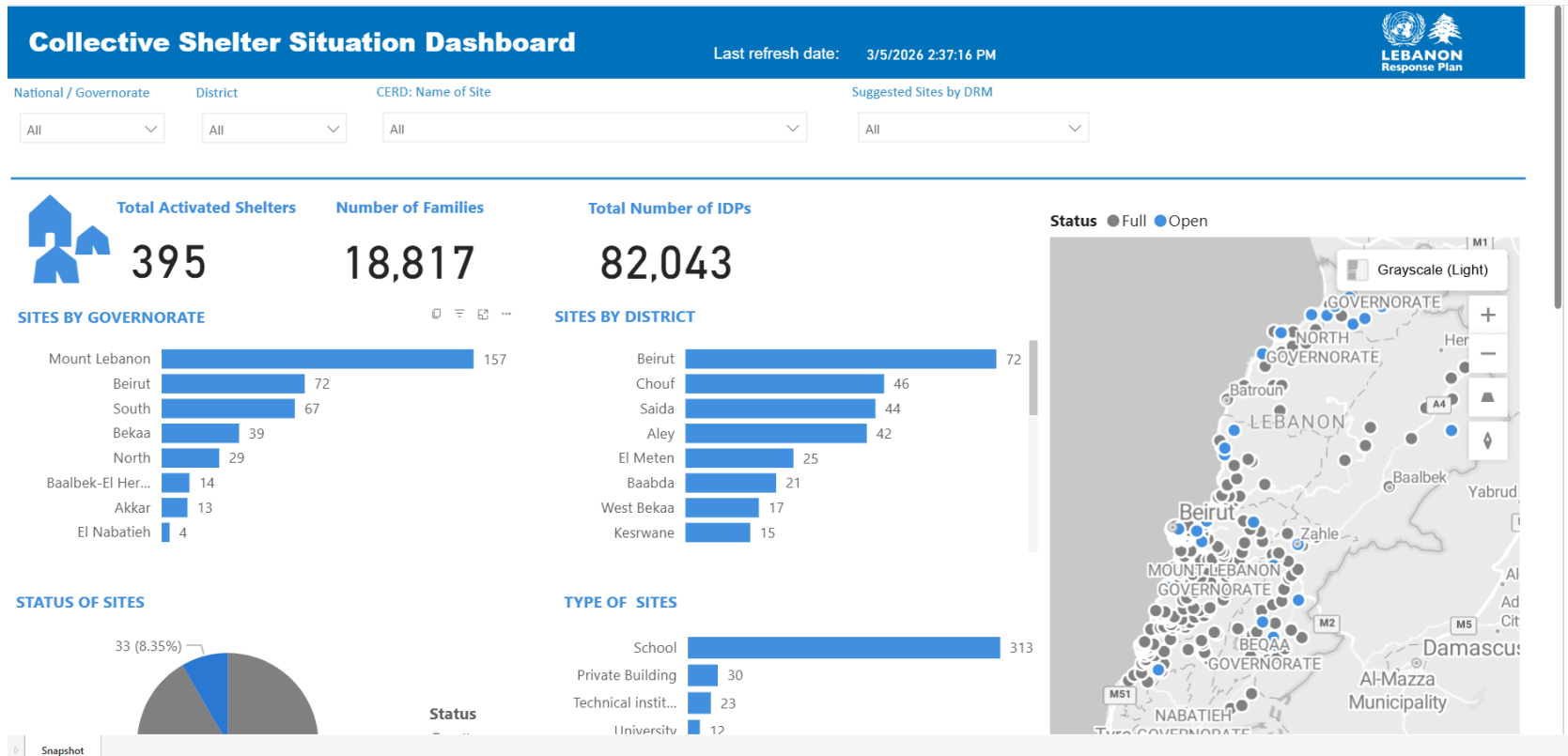





- To ensure accurate tracking of the response to the ongoing IDP situation, sectors are requested to closely follow-up with their partners to report their activities **DAILY** through [ActivityInfo](#) by **16:00**, covering assistance provided both inside and outside collective shelters.
- The information feeds into DRM dashboard, and government briefings.
- Delays in reporting will result in gaps in the overall response picture.
- Step-by-Step Guide has been shared with all partners & ActivityInfo users by email.
