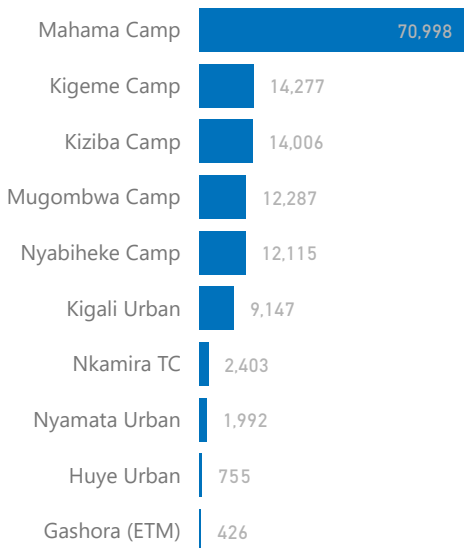

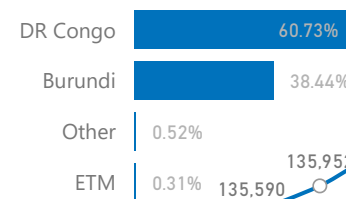

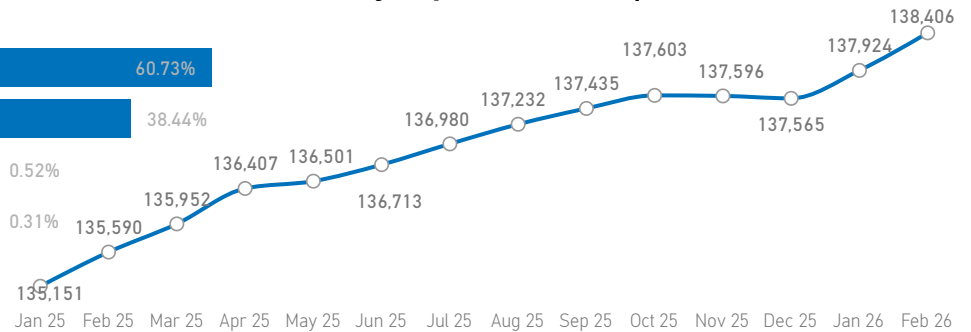

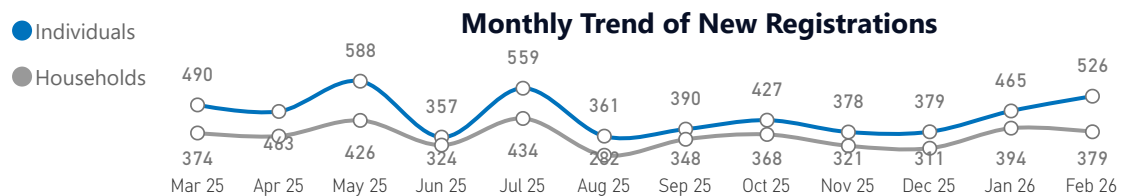

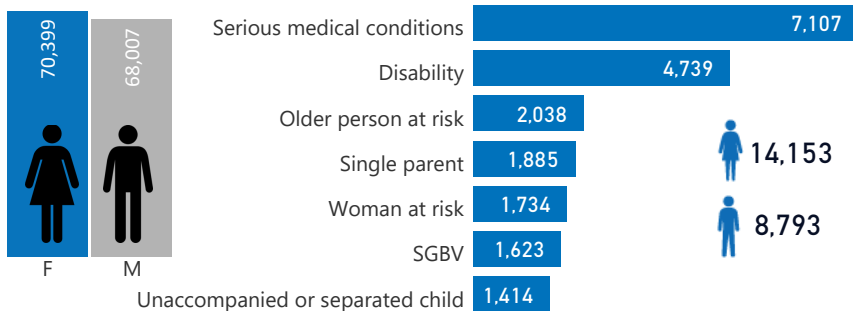


Monthly Trend of New Registrations

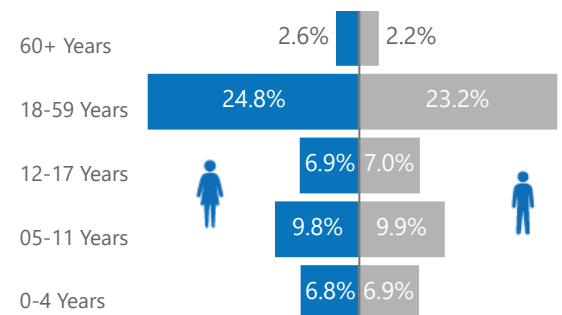


In February 2026, 31 Congolese new arrivals were received in Nkamira TC. In total, the registration of 39 new arrivals is still pending.

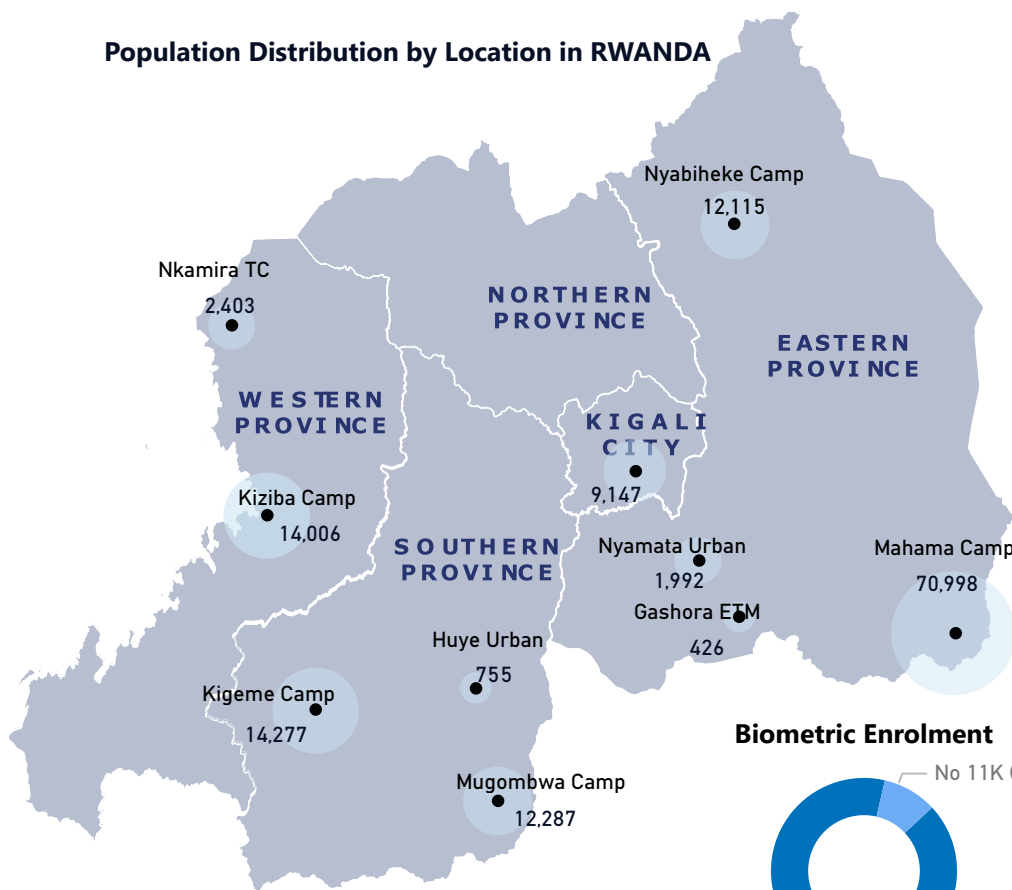

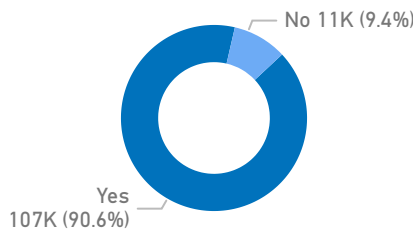


The total population of 138,406 includes 116,405 refugees, 15,491 registered asylum seekers, 39 non registered asylum seekers, and 6,471 Others of concern. Since the start of 2026, 991 individuals (including 623 new births and 337 new arrivals) have been registered in Rwanda. Among them are 7% of whom are new arrivals from DR Congo 2% from Burundi and 22 % from Sudan; 69% remaining are mainly for new births and InSitu registration. There was an increase of 482 individuals in the population from last month, resulting from new arrivals and continuous registration activities.

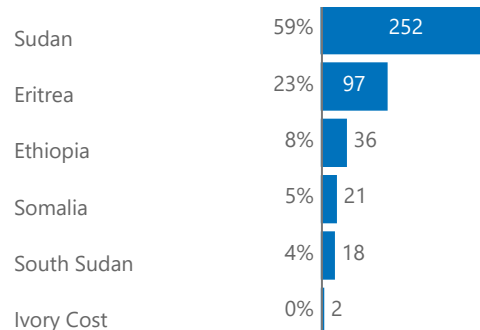
Population Distribution by Location in RWANDA

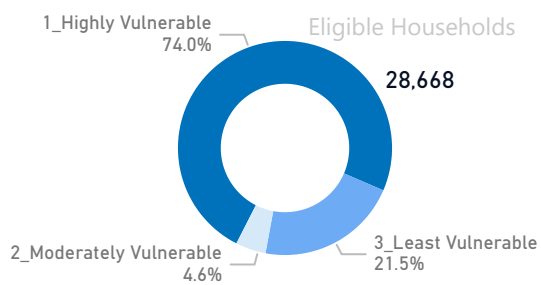

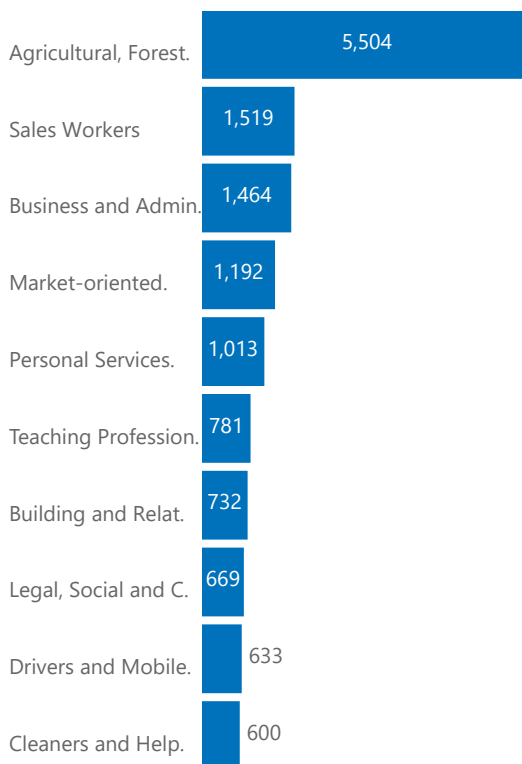

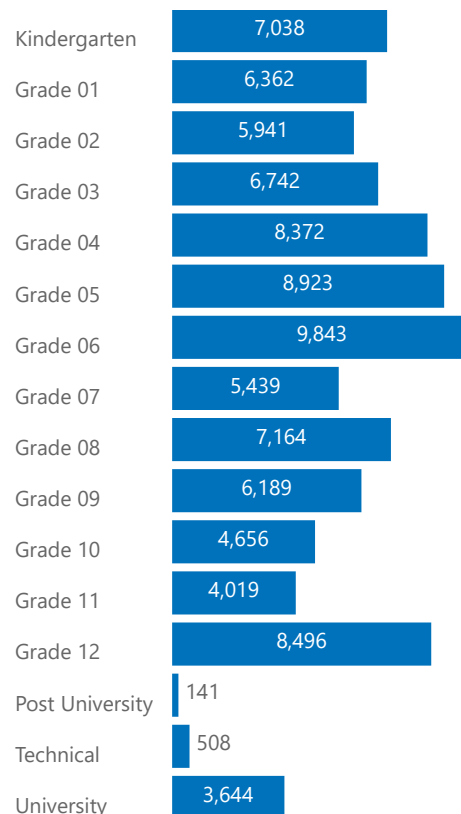
