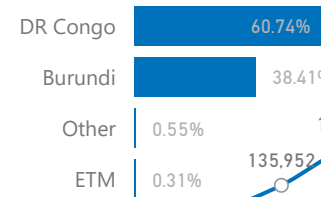

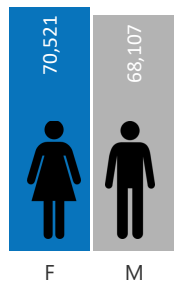
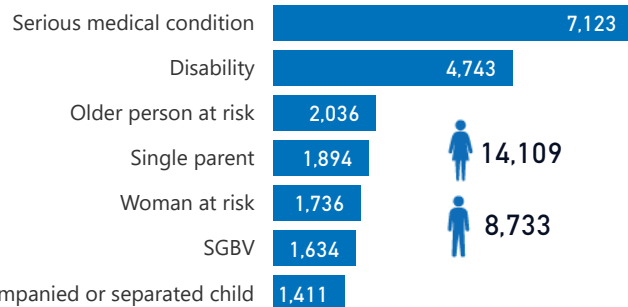


Monthly Trend of New Registrations

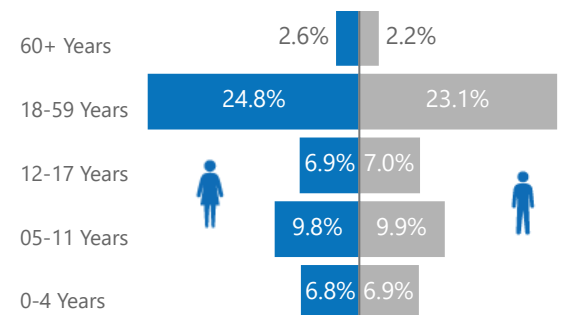


In March 2026, 12 Congolese new arrivals were received in Nkamira TC. In total, the registration of 15 new arrivals is still pending.

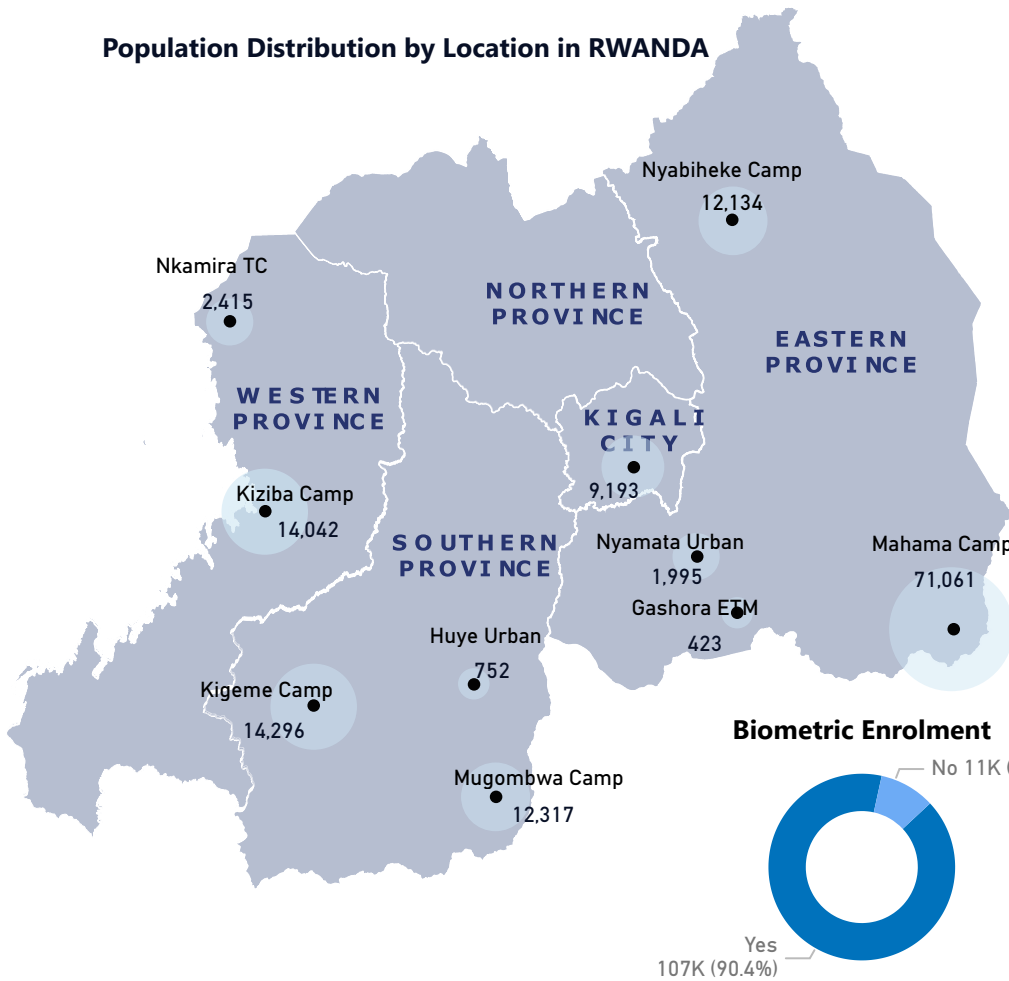

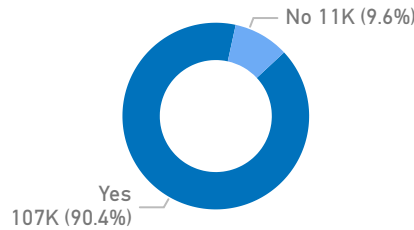


The total population of 138,628 includes 116,592 refugees, 15,534 registered asylum seekers, 15 non registered asylum seekers, and 6,487 Others of concern. Since the start of 2026, 1,391 individuals (including 919 new births and 411 new arrivals) have been registered in Rwanda. Among them are 7% of whom are new arrivals from DR Congo 2% from Burundi and 19% from Sudan; 72% remaining are mainly for new births and InSitu registration. There was an increase of 222 individuals in the population from last month, resulting from new arrivals and continuous registration activities.

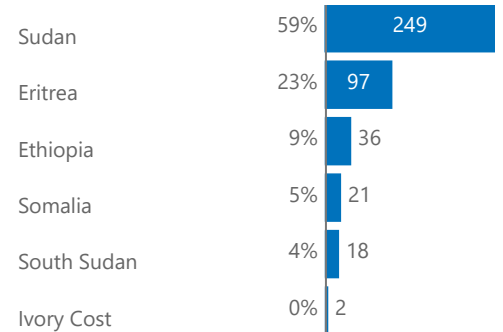
Population Distribution by Location in RWANDA

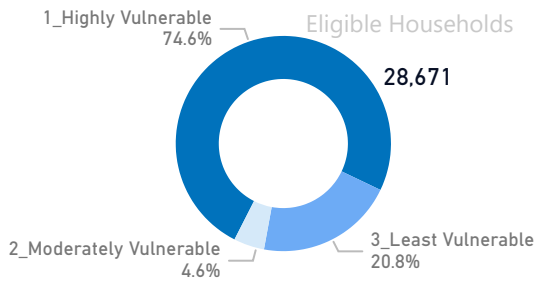

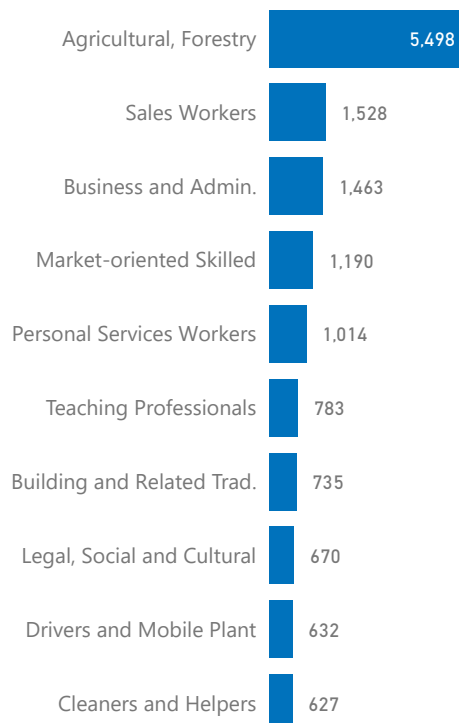

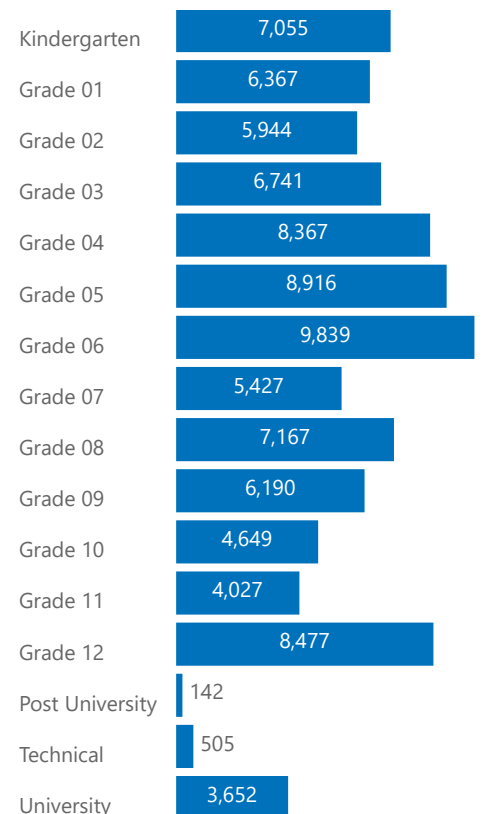
