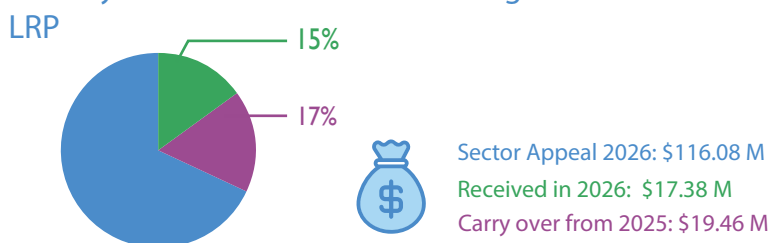

January - March 2026 Sector Funding Status *

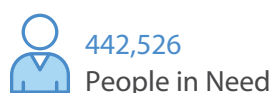
