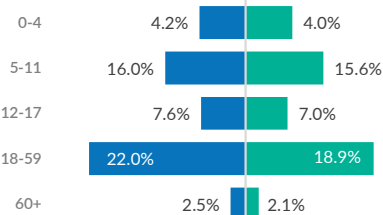

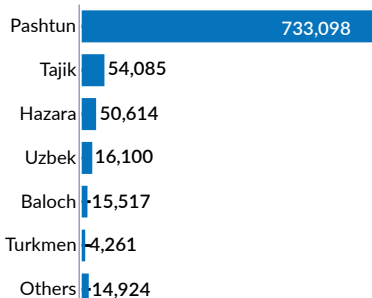

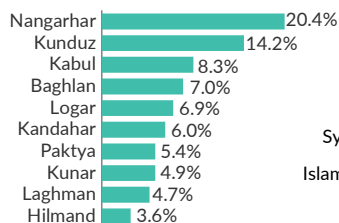

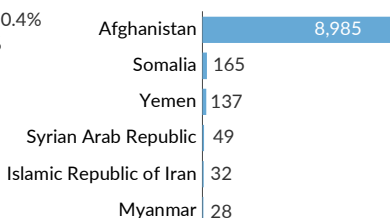
AFGHAN (PoR) CARD HOLDERS

REGISTERED REFUGEES UNDER UNHCR'S MANDATE

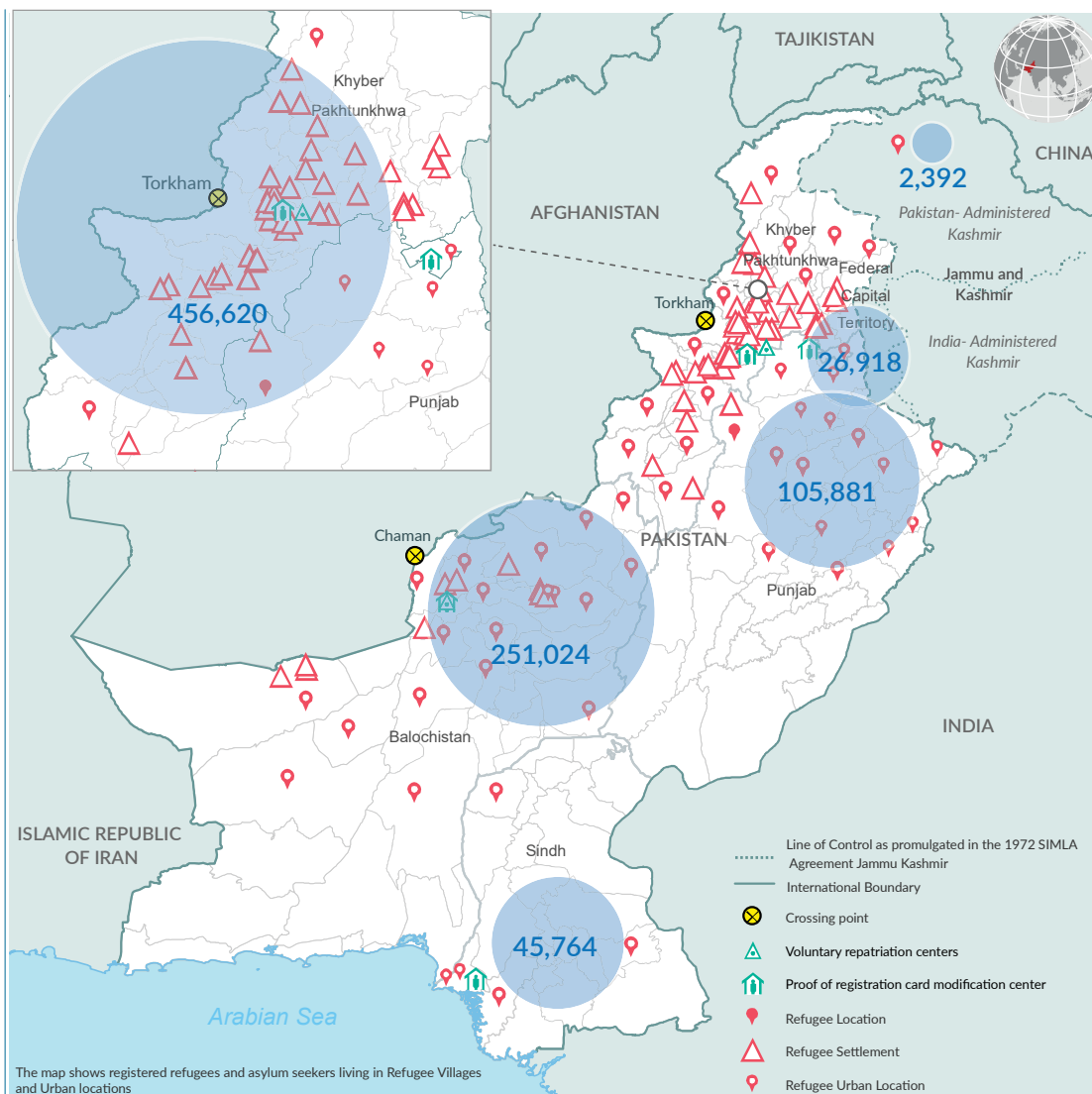
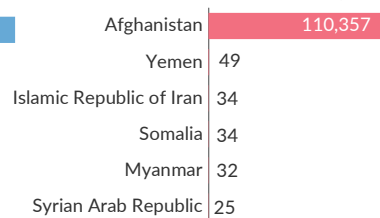
COUNTRY OF ORIGIN (TOP 6)



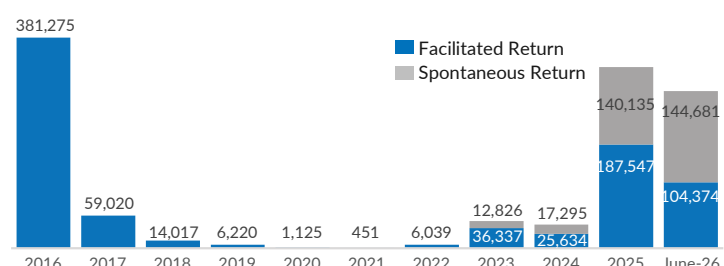

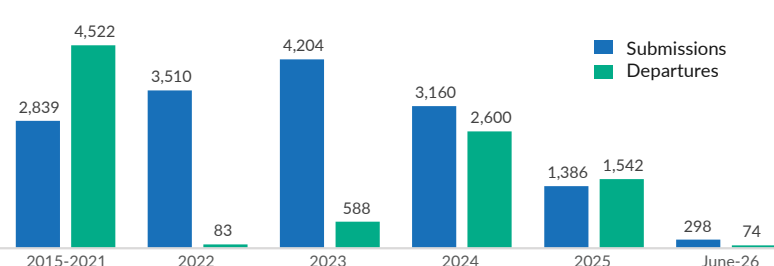
