



WEEKLY STATISTICS





Weekly registration: 25 -31 Mar.-2013

- During the current week (25 -31 Mar.) **375 individuals** have been registered;
- 61 out of 375 are newborns.
- 45.8% of new arrivals are minors and 54.2% are above 18 years.
- 44.3% are female, 55.7% are male;
- Rejections:**
9 individuals have been rejected for the following reasons:
 - 0 recyclers;
 - 3 active combatant;
 - 2 back and forth / visitors;
 - 3 not of concern (came for business purposes);
 - 1 secondary movement from Juba without family linkage in Yida.
- Transfers:**
 - 11 individuals transferred to Nyeel;
 - 11 individuals transferred to Ajong Thok
- Majority of new arrivals come from Umdoreen county followed by Al Boram (Katcha).

- INACTIVATION/RE-ACTIVATION:**
- 8 individuals were inactivated because they went back to Nuba.
 - 23 vulnerable individuals has been re-activated this week.
 - 36 individuals who missed verification have been rejected following interviews.
