



Weekly registration: 15-21 Apr.-2013


- ① During the current week (15-21 April), 211 individuals have been registered; 72 are active. With the intorduction of the new GoSS resolution, 139 individuals have been registered and not provided with ration cards in Yida.
- 2 5 out of 211 are newborns.
- **3** 57.77% of new arrivals are minors and 42.23% are above 18 years.
- **4** 54.03% are female, 45.97% are male;

- Tranfers:
- 47 individuals tranferred from Yida to Ajoung Thok. As of April 21 Ajoung Thok camp host 115 refugees.
- Majority of new arrivals come from Heban and Al Boram.

INACTIVATION/RE-ACTIVATION:

- 721 individuals were inactivated for no show during April GFD.
- 19 individuals have been re-activated this week.
 0 individuals who missed verification have been rejected following interviews.
