



WEEKLY STATISTICS





Weekly registration: 17-23 June.-2013

- During the current week (17 - 23 June), 40 individuals have been registered; 27 are active. With the introduction of the new GoSS resolution, 13 individuals have been registered and not provided with ration cards in Yida.
- 19 out 40 are newborns.
- 61.9% of new arrivals are minors and 38.1% are above 18 years.
- 52.5% are female, 47.5% are male;
- Rejections:**
No individuals have been rejected this week.
- Transfers:**
- 201 individuals were transferred from Yida to Ajoung Thok and 25 individuals previously registered in Pariang were transferred to Ajoung Thok starting off from Yida. 6 individuals were spontaneous arrival to Ajoung Thok . As of June 23 Ajoung Thok camp host 1,607 refugees.
- Majority of new arrivals come from Heban and Al Boram.

INACTIVATION/RE-ACTIVATION:

- 25 individuals were reactivated this week.
- 52 individuals have been inactivated this week because 46 went back to Nuba ,5 went to kakuma and 1 went to Juba.
- No individuals who missed verification were rejected following interviews
- 3 individuals were closed, they died.

Cumulative statistics and trends

- 71,080 individuals, 17,113 households** are registered in Yida camp 64.87% are females head of household and 35.13% are males.
- INACTIVATION (Cumulative):**
- 27,483 individuals have been totally inactivated.
- REFUGEES ON HOLD (Cumulative):**
- 1,017 have been registered and put on hold (registered without RC).
