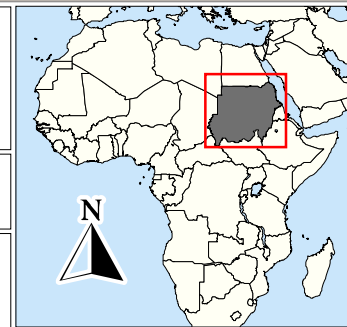

Situation:

- Over 79,753 persons have arrived in Sudan
- 50,027 persons have received humanitarian assistance (specific assistance only).
- Sudan hosts an estimated 350,000 Southern Sudanese individuals following the separation of South Sudan from Sudan.
