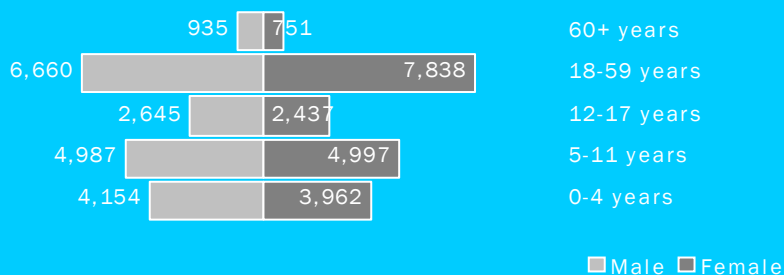

Monthly New Registration Trends



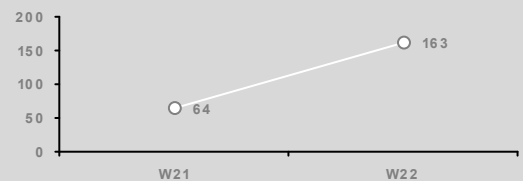
