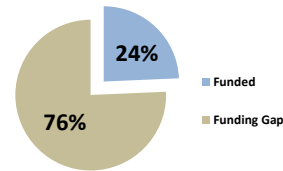


SOUTH SUDAN REFUGEE EMERGENCY REVISED REGIONAL RESPONSE PLAN
