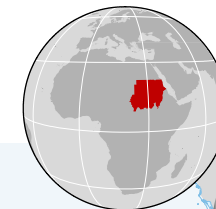


SUDAN: Arrivals from South Sudan | 15 December 2013 - 06 November 2014



Over **106,162** persons have arrived in Sudan from South Sudan

- 65,887 persons have received humanitarian assistance (specific assistance only)

- Sudan hosts an estimated 350,000 Southern Sudanese individuals following the separation of South Sudan from Sudan
