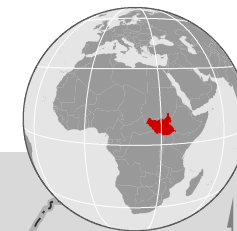
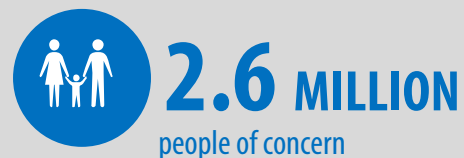

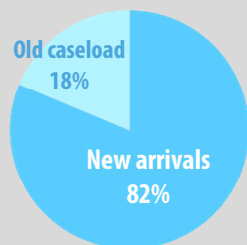

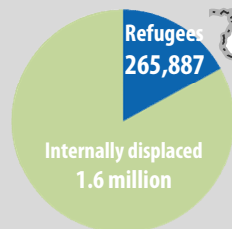
Total refugees from South Sudan in Ethiopia, Kenya, Sudan and Uganda

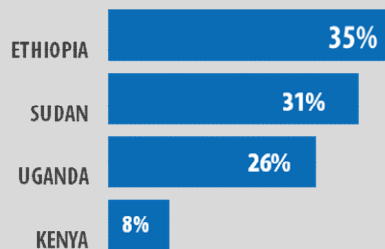

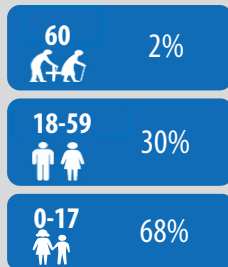
