






Monthly total population



Monthly individual population trend





Monthly new registration trend (Total 2014: 1,850 individuals)




Monthly Resettlement (Total 2014: 46 individuals)











Population statistics as of 31 January 2014



Total population: 199,704 43,157

Dollo Ado came into the global picture in early 2009 when UNHCR opened the Bokolmanyio camp to accommodate refugees fleeing insecurity in Somalia. Now, five years on, the small town in south-eastern Ethiopia on the border with Somalia is the second largest refugee operation in the world accommodating more than 199,704 Somali refugees in five camps.






