

Overview

In summary, close to 9,000 civilians were displaced during the reporting period (almost the double of last week's figure of new IDPs). Marka and the outskirts of Mogadishu are now major places of new displacement. IDPs in these locations are in need of assistance.

Displacement to Luuq town (Gedo)

According to UNHCR partners, between 150-500 individuals arrived to Luuq from Buurdhuubo (southern Gedo). The estimated total number of new IDPs in Luuq since the beginning of March is now around 2,150 persons. IDPs from Buurdhuubo are of the same clan as Luuq host community and are accommodated by extended family members from Luuq. However, IDPs from Wajid (Bakool region) are not of same clan and, according to reports, are in need of shelter and food.

Displacement to Bay from Shabelle Hoose

Another 300 IDPs arrived to Buur Hakaba (Bay region) from Qoryooley while around 100 IDPs originating from the same area arrived to Baidoa.

Displacement inside Shabelle Hoose

Around 5,000 civilians arrived to Marka from Qoryooley town over the last couple of days. The total number of new IDPs in Marka is now 6-7,000 persons.

Displacement to Mogadishu

Around 3,500 IDPs from Qoryooley district (Shabelle Hoose) arrived to Mogadishu (Km 7-13). The total estimated number of new IDPs in Mogadishu is now more 6-7,000 persons.
