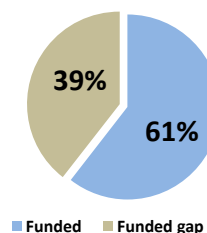


# 2014 CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC REVISED REGIONAL REFUGEE RESPONSE PLAN
