
Highlights

- There is no new number reported by the Government of Turkey on August 30, 2012. Official numbers remained the same; 80,410. Reportedly there are still people waiting across the border on the Syrian side and are admitted in smaller groups and referred to the camps. The basic humanitarian assistance is provided to those who are waiting across the border at zero point of the border.
- According to the information from the camp officials of Akçakale and Ceylanpınar in Şanlıurfa, a total of 527 persons left the camp voluntarily from two camp camps in Şanlıurfa and returned to Syria. The returnees are provided transportation by the Government of Turkey until to the border.
- According to the information from the authorities, the two camps in Kahramanmaraş and Gaziantep-Karkamış are operational. Reportedly those who are temporarily accommodated in the schools are now being transferred to the camps.
- Local authorities informed that the camp in Osmaniye is expected to be operational, reportedly as of first week of September 2012.
