


### Highlights

- On 07 July 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and accommodated in 20 camps in 10 provinces was 200,043. The total number includes 396 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that the number of those who voluntarily returned to Syria (1,531) from the camps during the last 3 days (5-7 July 2013) was slightly higher than the number of new arrivals (1,521) registered and accommodated in the camps.
- Local authorities in Kilis informed UNHCR that on Friday and during the weekend (5-7 July), some 400 Syrians living in the make shift camp in the park in Kilis were transferred to Mardin-Midyat camp. UNHCR Field team was in close contact with the authorities both in Kilis and the Mardin-Midyat camp and reportedly all who were transferred were registered. On Saturday, UNHCR was informed that some of the park residents wanted to return to Syria. UNHCR Field Team was on the ground, talked to several people, and all were willing to return voluntarily. Local officials provided transportation and facilitated their movement to the border.
- The registration of the urban caseload in Gaziantep and Sanliurfa continued during the week and as of 05 July 2013, and the total number of non camp Syrians registered by authorities has increased to more than 200,000, of whom almost 64,000 were registered by the Coordination Centers in Gaziantep and Nizip, and more than 16,500 were registered in Sanliurfa province. Another 21,000 have registration appointments in Gaziantep.
- On 06-07 July 2013, the Under Secretary-General and SRSG on Children and Armed Conflict, Ms. Leila Zerrougui, visited the camps in Kilis and Gaziantep, met with the authorities and NGOs providing support to the refugees in urban, and visited refugee families in the camps and urban. Ms. Zerrougui thanked the Government of Turkey for its generosity in keeping borders open to those who seek asylum and for providing temporary protection as well as the quality of the services provided to the Syrian refugees.
