

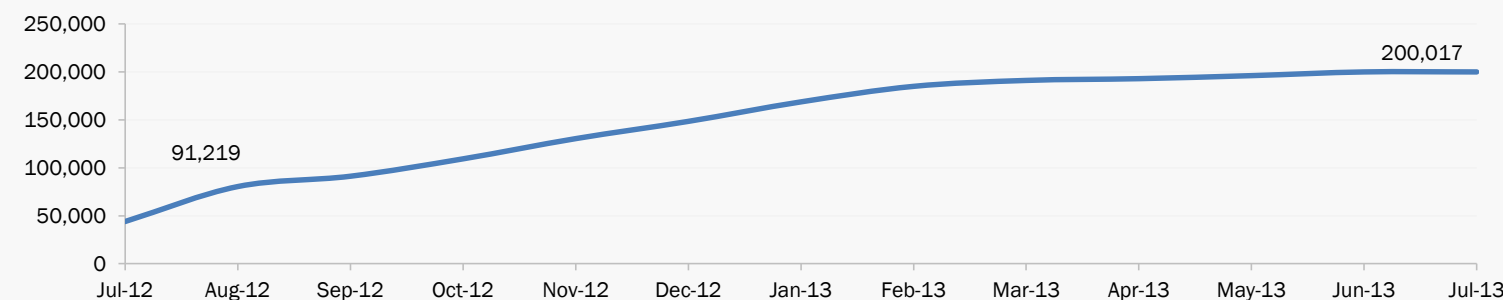

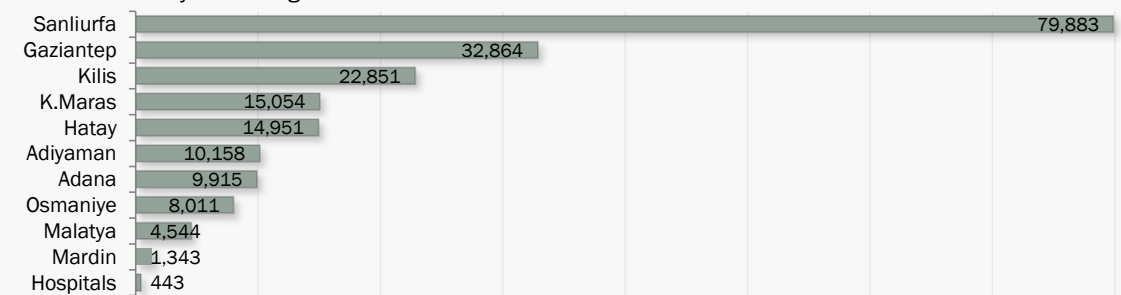

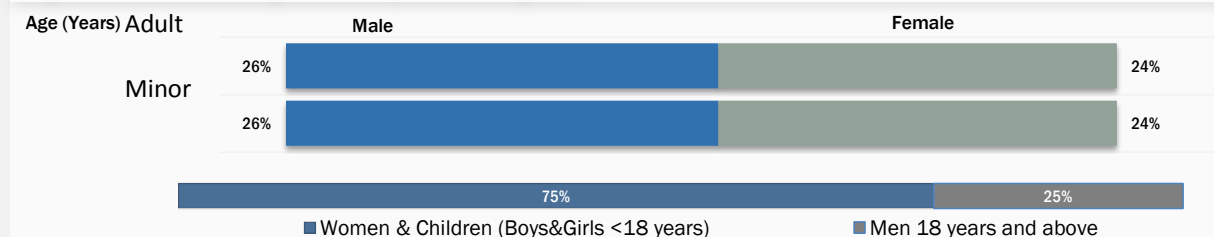

The number of Syrians living in the Urban Area are not included

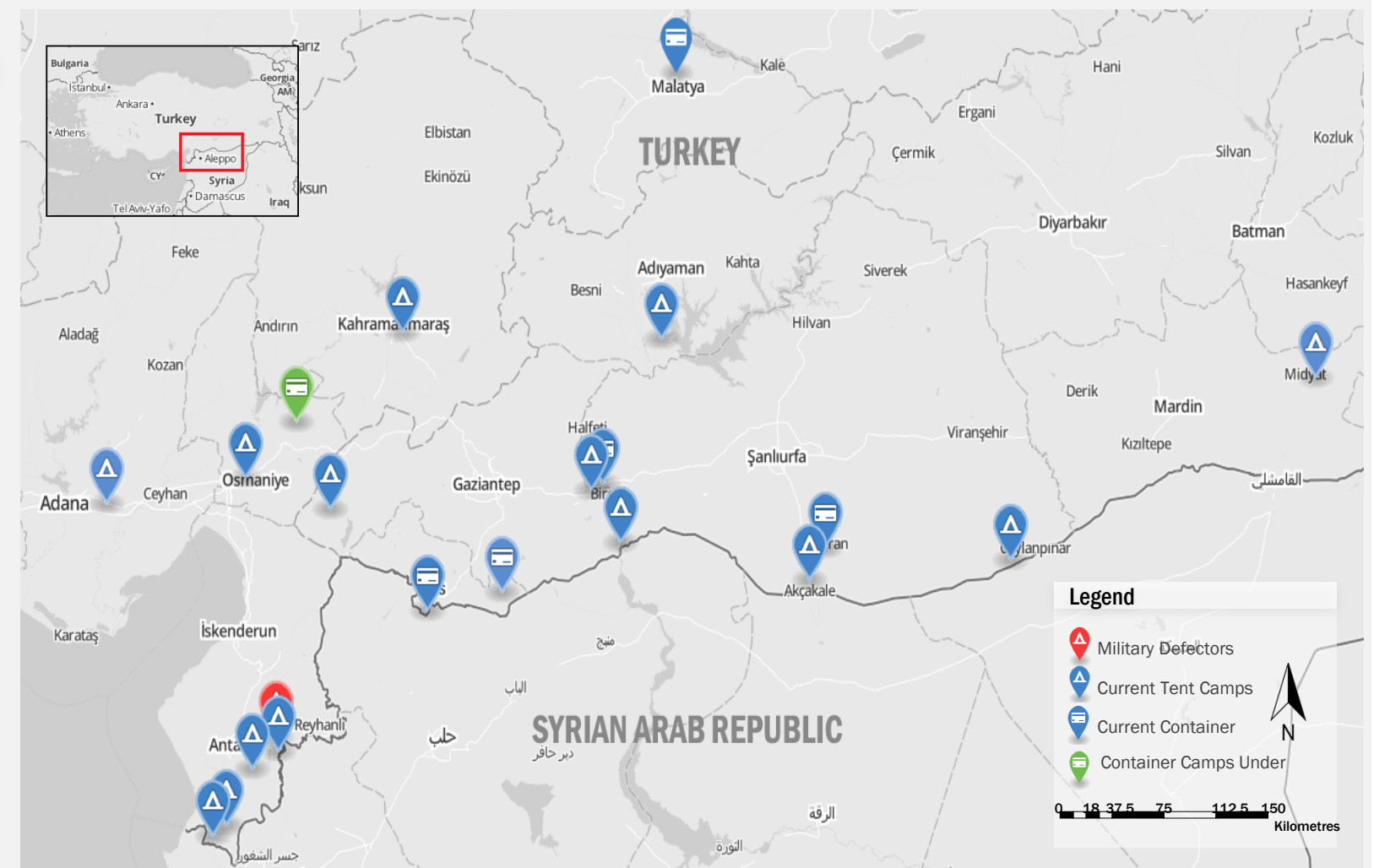


Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



Highlights

- On 11 July 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 20 camps in 10 provinces increased to 200,017 including 443 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the last 24hrs (10-11 July), 459 new arrivals were admitted and accommodated in the camps while some 493 Syrians voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Local officials in Islahiye informed UNHCR that there are approximately 5,000 Syrians living in urban in Islahiye. Reportedly they were counted by a local NGO and assisted through the existing assistance mechanisms available in town. Sub-governor of Islahiye informed UNHCR that unfortunately there is no space available in the camp to accommodate the group of 150-200 who are waiting in the mosque next to the camp. Reportedly they were offered to be transferred to Mardin-Midyat camp but the group did not accept. Therefore the officials are working through the local NGO and the local community to find appropriate accommodation conditions in town.
- In Osmaniye the local officials informed the UNHCR Field Team that they have enumerated about 1,600 families (about 6,000 people) living in Osmaniye province. Reportedly after the incident in Reyhanli on 11 May, many Syrians moved to Osmaniye including Turkomans and Arabs. AFAD Officials in Osmaniye informed UNHCR Field team that they are waiting clearance from central authorities in Ankara to start the registration of urban Syrians in Osmaniye. In the mean time the AFAD Osmaniye started to provide the 80% of the cost of the prescriptions of the urban Syrians and so far 117 persons' prescriptions are covered.
- Camp officials of Osmaniye confirmed that UNHCR donated 2,050 kitchen cabinets and mini-fridges have been received and distributed to the Syrians in the camps. Another 1,800 mini-fridges and kitchen cabinets were received and distributed in Islahiye camp. In the coming week, 2,500 shelves will be delivered to Kahramanmaras and Karkamis camps.
