NEEDS

Kurdistan Region, northern Iraq

The significant number of new arrivals has placed immense pressure on shelter and other infrastructure in Domiz. It is expected that by the end of 2013, an estimated number of 50,000 Syrian refugees will arrive to the central and southern Governorates of Iraq, which will place a considerable pressure on the existing camps and also on host communities.

UNHCR and relevant partners were drafting the winterization plan for all camps as well as for non-camp refugees. We are also assuming that the current arrival trend continues to the end of the year and therefore we will have a total caseload of approximately 300,000 refugees arriving into the Kurdistan region. Using the previously agreed split of Non Camp (60%) to Camp (40%) caseload, we are planning to support up to 180,000 Non Camp refugees and 120,000 Camp refugees as part of winterisation activities.

UNHCR in cooperation with local authorities (DMC and ERC) is planning and developing drainage systems in various camp locations.

OBJECTIVE

Shelter and Infrastructure established, improved and maintained.

ACTION/OUTPUTS

- Camp: Emergency shelter provided.
- Camp & non-camp: Shelter materials and maintenance tool kit provided.

KEY SEPTEMBER DEVELOPMENTS

- The Government started to return to Syrian refugees their previously confiscated ID-cards.
- The Darashakran camp was completed at the end of the month and ready to receive refugees.
- Bajed Kandela transit camp was opened and relocation from Zhako did commence, as well as Gewelan camp (transit area) opened and received refugees from Barderash.
- An assessment mission to Al Qa'im was conducted by a site planner to review the urgent required winterization needs.
- Concrete foundation platforms are being constructed in some of the camps as part of the winterization plan.

ACHIEVEMENTS TO DATE



57,000 refugees have received shelter/tents



1,190 tents erected in Gawilan transit area, Qasrok and Arbat transit.



Communal tents in Bajed Kandela transit have been supplied by UNHCR and erected by DMC. The transit site has capacity for 1,200 individuals.



Construction of the Admin. and Services area in Darashakran has started, incl. warehouses, distribution facilities, schools and registration center.



Site planning for Gawilan is completed, planning of Qushtatpa and Basirma is ongoing.
