


Highlights

- On 24 November 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 205,171 including 95 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the weekend (22- 24 Nov. 2013) 1,370 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 840 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Akcakale camp, the local officials informed that there was a fire and a camp resident was injured and hospitalized. The camp management decided to remove all the annexes to the main tents which the camp residents have built, among others to connect tents with each other. The same problem also exists in Hatay Altinozu Boynuyogun camp and Karkamis camp.
- In Harran camp, the camp management together with the support of the local association called "Association for Development of Sanliurfa Villages" organized a communal ceremony for the circumcision of the boys in the camp. Reportedly some 100 boys were circumcised on 14 November. The atmosphere was festive, however while some of the camp residents were happy to have the celebrations in the camp, others expressed disapproval to the camp management as they were mourning family members killed in Syria.
- UNHCR continues to advocate with the camp officials to ensure that no marriages of minors take place in the camps. In Kilis Oncupinar camp, the camp manager informed UNHCR that they have discussed the issue with the imams and warned them of possible charges brought against them as it is illegal in Turkey to marry persons under the age of 18. Reportedly the imams in Oncupinar camp will raise awareness on this issue during the Friday prayers.
- In Kilis Elbeyli camp, the officials informed that they have about 150 empty containers in the camp which the officials are planning to use for Syrians admitted from Bab-Al Salame in Syria. It is not clear when the IDPs from Bab Al-Salame will be admitted. Reportedly the camp officials were instructed not to accept people from those who are approaching the gate spontaneously and claim to have relatives in the camp. Still, those who have immediate core family members (parents, children, husbands, wives etc.) continue to be accepted and accommodated in the containers of their family members.
