



# PROTECTION-Statistics

- For refugees registered between Jan and Oct 2013 – apparent downward trend in the no. of monthly new arrivals
- No. of new appointments for registration – reduction in the number of appointments requested over the last 3 months (Sep -20,000, Oct – 18,000, Nov -14,000)
- Current average waiting time from arrival to registration: 33 days.
- Goal: reduction to 29 days in the coming months

# Registration statistics

- 24% decrease in new appointments request in past 2 months.
- 84% of the 1,000,000 target (registered & scheduled)
- Continued decrease in back log- ***Biggest drop since January 2013***
- Verification and Renewals commenced-14 months plan.
- Biometrics for non-Syrian population.



# Aarsal

## Statistics:

35,000 (host community)

21,500 (refugees registered with UNHCR as of 10 Dec)

20,000 plus (latest influx since 15 Nov)

76,500 persons



# Aarsal

- 2D bar code reader piloted.
- Arrival of 10-11 new families/day.
- Emergency response registration replaced by outreach/BNA.



# Aarsal

- Pre-November 14 municipality backlog: cleared by DRC and UNHCR (1,700 forms entered)
- 11 December: 21,127 individuals registered by DRC
- 40-60 families approaching registering with UNHCR past week




# The current situation


- Sectors using archaic systems (excel, word files)
- No common approach
- Multiplication of reports (field, sectors, M&E of agencies)
- Difficult to consolidate
- Limited capacity to analyse
- No common definition of indicators

Partners deliver assistance and need to report their activities to:






UNHCR Lebanon has 34 implementing partners

There are over 100 actors in Lebanon


Users of reports still need to compile and analyse all this data


# A REPORTING INTERFACE BETWEEN ACTORS AND USERS



# WHAT IS ACTIVITY-INFO?

- An online/offline monitoring tool which collects, manages, maps and analyzes data on indicators
- Tracks progress against defined targets
- Generates custom reports: charts, tables and maps

# One-Stop Shop!




## What can be solved by AI?

- Overload of reporting
- Different systems in different sectors
- Incoherent data
- Dedicated staffing constantly required
- Delayed reporting

## What cannot be solved by AI?

- Data collection by partners (solution work-in-progress)
- Validity and reliability of data
- Unwillingness of partners to report
