

Highlights

- On 25 December 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 210,627 including 153 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the last 2 days (23-25) Dec 2013, a total of 1,493 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 245 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria. There is no one in the Kilis transit center.
- Local officials in Sanliurfa informed that there is an increasing number of Syrians spontaneously arriving at the camps (Akcakale, Viransehir and Ceylanpinar camps). Reportedly, while the majority of these spontaneous arrivals stated they came directly from Syria (Aleppo, Idlib, Deyrezzor) because of the recent attacks by the Syrian Government forces, some others stated that they were living outside of the camps, but because of the bad weather conditions they came to Sanliurfa to seek shelter in camps.
- In Kilis province, the police registered about 12,000 non-camp Syrians living in Kilis city center since the circular of General Directorate of Security (GDS). Local officials in Kilis informed that the governorate of Kilis will distribute coal to the vulnerable families of the registered people, which encouraged the non-registered Syrians living in town to approach the police. In addition, an international NGO also informed UNHCR that they will provide winterization kits to the vulnerable families in Kilis.
- In Birecik town of Sanliurfa province, about 3,500 non-camp Syrians were registered and fingerprinted. Reportedly the Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundation (SASF) of Birecik town and Turkish Red Crescent are building a school in Birecik town for the children of non-camp Syrians in Birecik town. Local officials also stated that the SASF and the women's committee of the Turkish Red Crescent are also collecting donations and providing assistance to the vulnerable families identified during their assessments. Reportedly they have so far identified some 200 families in need of assistance.
- In addition to the heaters that UNHCR is providing to the camps, Turkish Red Crescent has stated, that it will provide, with the support of German Red Cross, some 15,500 heaters to the camps where needed. UNHCR is working with Kizilay to avoid duplications and ensure all the camps receive heaters.
