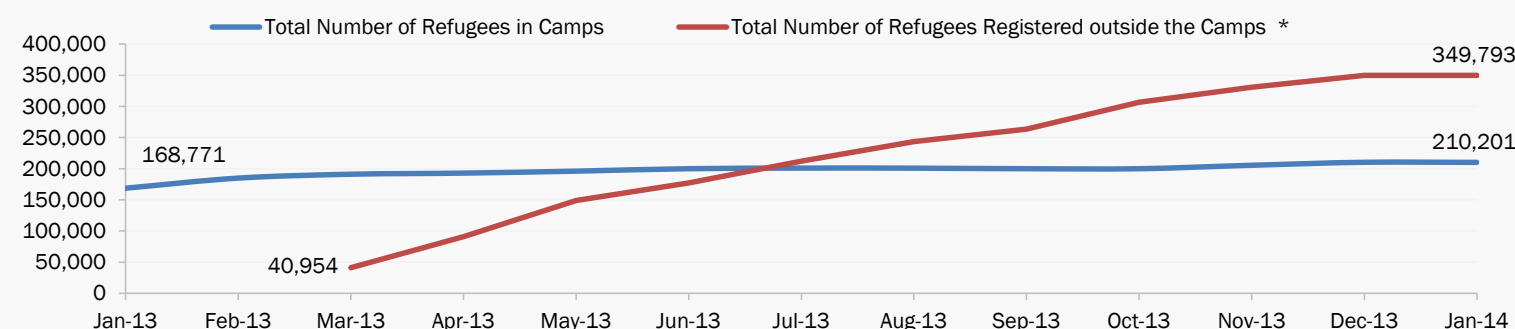

Highlights

- On 01 January 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps located in 10 provinces was 210,201 including 105 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the first 24 hrs. of 2014, a total of 378 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 377 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria. No new numbers were reported by AFAD on 02 Jan 2013.
- In Mardin Midyat camp, officials informed that they have provided 185 TL vouchers to all 18 teachers to buy suits for the classes.
- During the last week, the local officials in Viransehir and Mardin, informed that the camp in Nusabin is not yet ready although it was reported that the admissions will start in the end of first week of Jan. 2014. Reportedly the officials of both camps agreed that the transfer of 3,000 people temporarily accommodated in the waiting area in Viransehir is postponed. The local officials in Mardin informed that they are also waiting for one of the UNHCR procured mobile registration units to register the new arrivals when the admissions start. Initially the camp was planned as transit center however upon request from the central government officials the site-planning of the camp is slightly changed and one of the districts will be used for social activities.
- In Adana Saricam camp, 30 participants of the airconditioner maintenance course have received their graduation certificates from MEKSA, the Foundation on Vocational Courses supporting the small enterprises.
- In Karkamis town, local officials informed UNHCR that through the SASF (Social Assistance and Solidarity Foundation) they have identified 40 vulnerable families (more than 200 persons) in need of assistance. Reportedly these families will be provided food packages, and NFIs that were received from a German NGO.
- In Kilis Elbeyli camp, one of the school managers informed UNHCR about their challenges. He stated as the main challenge that all 16 classes are overcrowded as they have about 50 children in each classroom which has a negative impact on the quality of the education.
