

Highlights

- On 15 January 2014, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 213,404 including 124 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the period of 14-15 Jan 2014, a total of 426 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 254 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- UNHCR continues to advocate for the establishment of the Refugee Committees (youth committee, women committee) in the camps that will be in close contact with the camp managers. The Youth Committee in Harran offers a good practice example. In Altinozu Boynuyogun, officials informed UNHCR that they have established a women committee with the support from UNHCR.
- In Akcakale camp, the head of education facilities informed that they have established a special class for the disabled children in the school. Reportedly 26 children (18 boys and 8 girls) have been so far registered to this class. The school director of the camp also added that they have established a children's committee with 40 children, both girls and boys, from the age of 6 to 14 years.
- Three of the mobile coordination centers were sent to Sanliurfa province. The mobile centers were temporarily stationed in Harran camp. Local officials in Sanliurfa reported that one of these centers will be stationed in Akcakale town, one will be based in Sanliurfa city center and the third will be sent to Gaziantep.
- In Osmaniye local officials informed UNHCR that a prefabricated school with 20 classes is under construction in Osmaniye city center and is planned to be opened by mid Feb. 2014. Reportedly about 1,350 Syrian children living outside of the camps were registered to attend school and there will be about 151 Syrian teachers working in this school. The school is supported by the Governorate.
- The camp population of Viransehir increased to more than 8,500 refugees. The camp management informed UNHCR that while admissions are still on going, they have so far identified 2,758 children at school age. However they could not start education and are waiting for school furniture.
